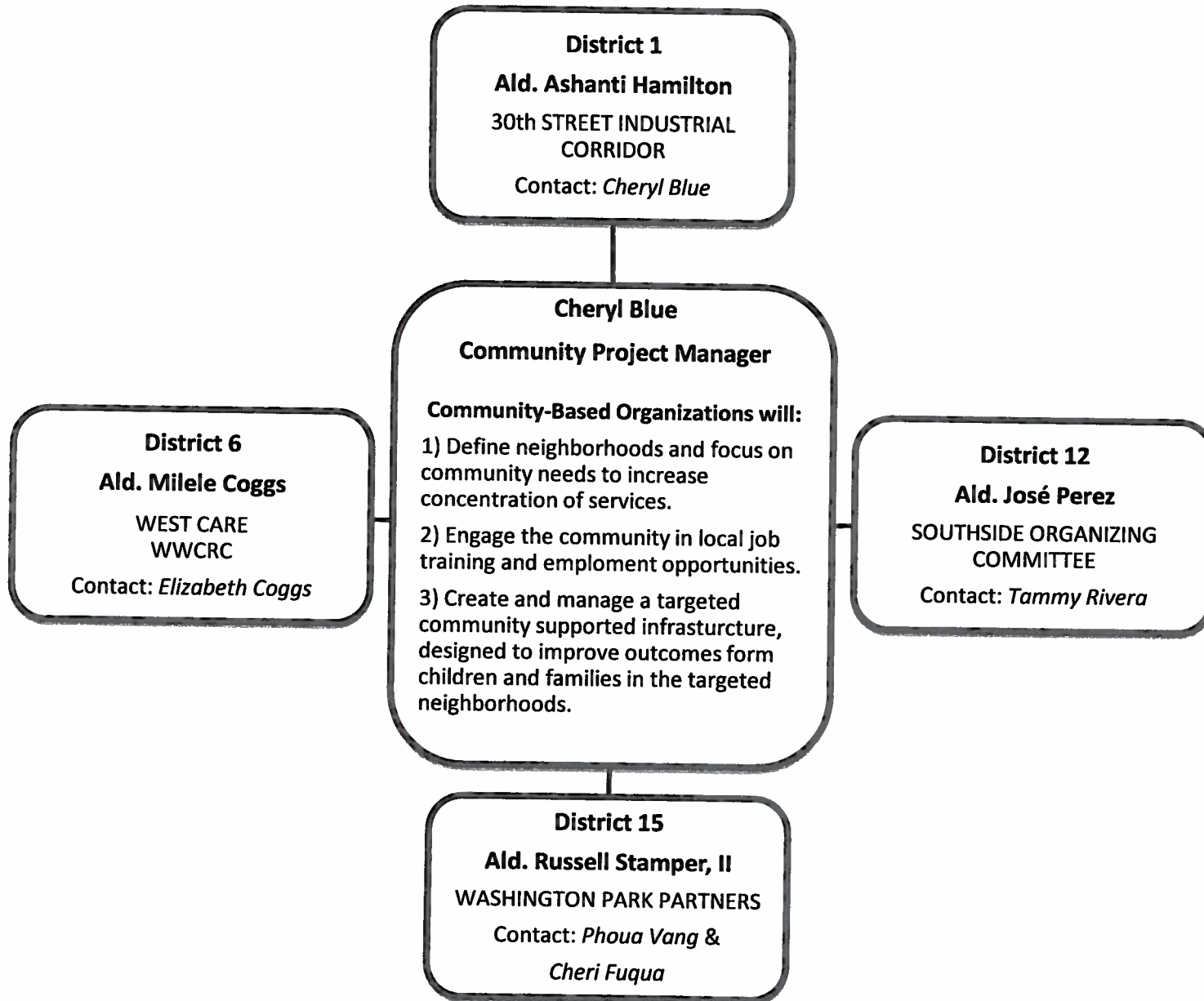

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

MACPYLES CORPORATION

MacPyles Corporation is partnering with the Milwaukee Promise Zones by providing assistance to youth ages 16-19 years old with employment and training through the implementation of the Village Redemption Project. The project is designed to enhance participants' employability through professional development and mentoring, internship and technical assistance. Participants complete a 4-week training clinic (4 nights per week for 4 subsequent weeks). Upon completion participants are rewarded a stipend and employment at MacPyles.
