## FINANCE & PERSONNEL COMMITTEE JAMES CARROLL

File #010670 is a substitute Charter Ordinance relating to retirement benefits for employees represented by the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A, AFL-CIO.

## **Background & Discussion**

- The 1998-2000 labor contract between the City and the Milwaukee Police Association included a provision to increase the longevity pay for police officers with 20 years of service to \$850 (\$100 increase). The increase is pensionable and employees who retired during 1998 and after with 20 years of service have the \$850 included in their Final Average Salary for the purposes of computing their service retirement allowance.
- 2. The charter ordinance modifies the City Code of Ordinances to implement the longevity provision agreed to in 1998-2000 labor contract between the City and the MPA.

## **Fiscal Impact**

The charter ordinance has no fiscal impact.
