File #010670 is a substitute Charter Ordinance relating to retirement benefits for employees represented by the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A, AFL-CIO.

### **Background & Discussion**

1. The 1998-2000 labor contract between the City and the Milwaukee Police Association included a provision to increase the longevity pay for police officers with 20 years of service to \$850 (\$100 increase). The increase is pensionable and employees who retired during 1998 and after with 20 years of service have the \$850 included in their Final Average Salary for the purposes of computing their service retirement allowance.
2. The charter ordinance modifies the City Code of Ordinances to implement the longevity provision agreed to in 1998-2000 labor contract between the City and the MPA.

### **Fiscal Impact**

The charter ordinance has no fiscal impact.
