
To Whom it May Concern:

Please allow this correspondence to serve as both a notice of injury and under §893.8(1d)(a) and a notice of claim under §893.8(1d)(b).

On May 21, 2024, I suffered burn injuries on both arms and both hands at 7676 N. 76th Street, while attempting to clean out the hopper of a dust collection system. I understand the Milwaukee Fire Department responded to a fire at that address on May 20, 2024 and put the fire out. I understand the fire department personnel on the scene informed my employer, Douglas Dynamics, that the fire was out and the system ready to be serviced when they left on May 20th. On the morning of May 21st my employer asked me to clean out the dust collector so the service company could come and start repairs. While using a crowbar to break loose the materials and the dust collector hopper, a cloud of hot dust broke free and ignited dust in the atmosphere around my arms causing 1st and 2nd degree burns.

My address is W153N5306 Plaza Drive, Menomonee Falls, WI 53051. I do not have a complete estimate of the damages but the current itemization includes several rounds of treatment for my burns and other medical and psychological treatment arising from the incident; several months of pain and suffering arising out of the healing process, scars related to the 1st and 2nd degree burns on both arms and future medical and psychological treatments required. The amount of my claim will exceed \$100,000 in total.
