Dear Committee Members:

Attached is File No. 001331, being a substitute resolution to vacate West Fairmount Avenue and West Lancaster Avenue both located between North 30th Street and North 31st Street; and a portion of North 30th Street between West Fairmount Avenue and West Lancaster Avenue, in the 1st Aldermanic District. This vacation was requested by Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District to support flood abatement efforts along Lincoln Creek.

The Department of Public Works Coordinated Report contains no stated objections to the proposed vacation. The Commissioner of Public Works has requested a deposit for the following costs:

1. Relocate 1 fire hydrant	\$3,500.00
2. Two sewer easements	<u>\$1,200.00</u>
TOTAL:	\$4,700.00

Since the proposed vacation is not in conflict with city plans, the City Plan Commission at its regular meeting on September 10, 2001 recommended approval for the attached substitute resolution.
