As a result of a complaint from a City of Milwaukee resident about traffic congestion during the morning rush hours on South Cesar E. Chavez Drive from West Pierce Street to West Greenfield Avenue a review of this section of roadway was conducted.

Our traffic engineering staff found that motorists are not obeying the current "No Parking 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM Monday through Friday" restriction, thereby blocking a moving lane of traffic. Therefore, to maintain the flow of traffic on this section of roadway during the morning rush hours we recommend the installation of a "No Stopping Tow-Away Zone 7:00 AM to 9:00 Am Monday through Friday" restriction.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
