

This case came before the court today for a ruling on the petitioners' request for reconsideration of the court's ruling denying its motion for a temporary injunction.

For the reasons stated on the record at today's hearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The petitioners' request for reconsideration is granted.
- 2. The court's November 13, 2013 ruling denying the petitioners' motion for a temporary injunction is vacated.
- 3. The petitioners' motion for a temporary injunction is granted.
- 4. The City of Milwaukee shall restore forthwith the petitioners' tavern and public entertainment premises licenses.
- 5. On or before December 9, 2013, the petitioners shall file a brief and supporting materials regarding their request for *certiorari* review of the suspension of their licenses and their position that the City is barred, under *State ex rel. Boroo v. Town of Barnes*, 10 Wis. 2d 153 (1960), from rehearing the recommendation that the petitioners' licenses be suspended.
- 6. On or before December 12, 2013, the City shall file a response.

- 7. On or before December 13, 2013, the petitioners may file a reply.
- 8. The court will rule on December 16, 2013 at 10:30 a.m.
