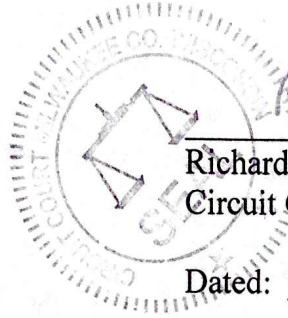
**ORDER**  
Case No. 13CV010227

This case came before the court today for a ruling on the petitioners' request for reconsideration of the court's ruling denying its motion for a temporary injunction.

For the reasons stated on the record at today's hearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The petitioners' request for reconsideration is granted.
2. The court's November 13, 2013 ruling denying the petitioners' motion for a temporary injunction is vacated.
3. The petitioners' motion for a temporary injunction is granted.
4. The City of Milwaukee shall restore forthwith the petitioners' tavern and public entertainment premises licenses.
5. On or before December 9, 2013, the petitioners shall file a brief and supporting materials regarding their request for *certiorari* review of the suspension of their licenses and their position that the City is barred, under *State ex rel. Boroo v. Town of Barnes*, 10 Wis. 2d 153 (1960), from rehearing the recommendation that the petitioners' licenses be suspended.
6. On or before December 12, 2013, the City shall file a response.

7. On or before December 13, 2013, the petitioners may file a reply.
8. The court will rule on December 16, 2013 at 10:30 a.m.
