The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolutions for Common Council approval:

<u>Breast Cancer Awareness Program</u> - This is a continuing grant funded by the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services. The purpose of the program is to educate and motivate women to take decisive actions that will prevent premature death and disability due to breast cancer. Funding changes resulted in changes to the Positions Ordinance.

MBCAP - Well Women Health Initiative Grant - This is also continuation funding from the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services. The grant funds will be used to expand the scope of the Wisconsin Women's Cancer Control Program beyond its current focus of breast and cervical cancers screening to include health promotion and risk reduction for cardiovascular disease, osteoporosis, diabetes, mental illness and domestic violence. Position changes are included in this resolution.

<u>Tuberculosis Control Program Grant</u> - This is new funding from the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services. The grant monies will be used to provide training to program staff and to purchase program participation incentives for high-risk clients.
