Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions, determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct and levy special assessments for the following improvements:

1st Aldermanic District
W. Fairmount Ave. - N. Hopkins St. to N. Sherman Blvd. (ST211160169): Install traffic calming speed hump(s).
Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$10,800; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$2,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$12,800. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.
7th and 10th Aldermanic Districts
N. 54th St. - W. Roosevelt Dr. to W. Keefe Ave. (ST211170118): Install traffic calming speed hump(s).
Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$9,700; Nonassessable Reconstruction

Paving Fund -- \$3,300). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$13,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

10th Aldermanic District
N. 56th St. - W. Wright St. to W. Clarke St. (ST211170106): Install traffic calming speed hump(s).
Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$3,700; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$3,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$6,700. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2017 construction season.

Further Resolved, That the proper departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting or adjacent properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the projects do not involve any parcels of agricultural land which are eligible for deferred special assessments under the provisions of Section 14.30 of the Milwaukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That project: W. Fairmount Ave. (ST211160169) will be billed after January 1, 2018, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed; and, be it

Further Resolved, That project: N. 54th St. (ST211170118) and N. 56th St. (ST211170106) will be billed after January 1, 2019, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed; and, be it
