File #011217 is a resolution relating to the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds in the amount of \$12,000,000 for School Board borrowing for Milwaukee Public School (MPS) capital purposes.

**Background and Discussion**

1. The Comptroller's Office annually submits initial-borrowing resolutions for projects and programs approved in the adopted budget.
2. The resolution authorizes the sale of general obligation bonds in the amount of \$12,000,000 MPS capital purposes.
3. The table below shows the projects and the amount of borrowing authorized by this resolution.

ADA Improvements	\$2,000,000
Major Maintenance to Facilities	\$7,500,000
Bradley Tech High School	\$2,500,000
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$12,000,000</b>

**Fiscal Impact**

Until the actual structuring of the debt issue is determined by the Public Debt Commission, details relating to the long-term fiscal impact will not be known. Depending on actual sale date in 2002, a maximum of 6 months interest would be incurred during the year. If sold after July 1, 2002, there would be no fiscal impact in 2002.
