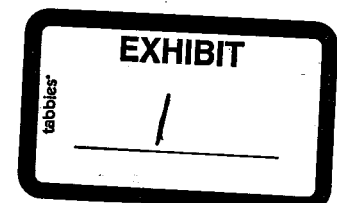

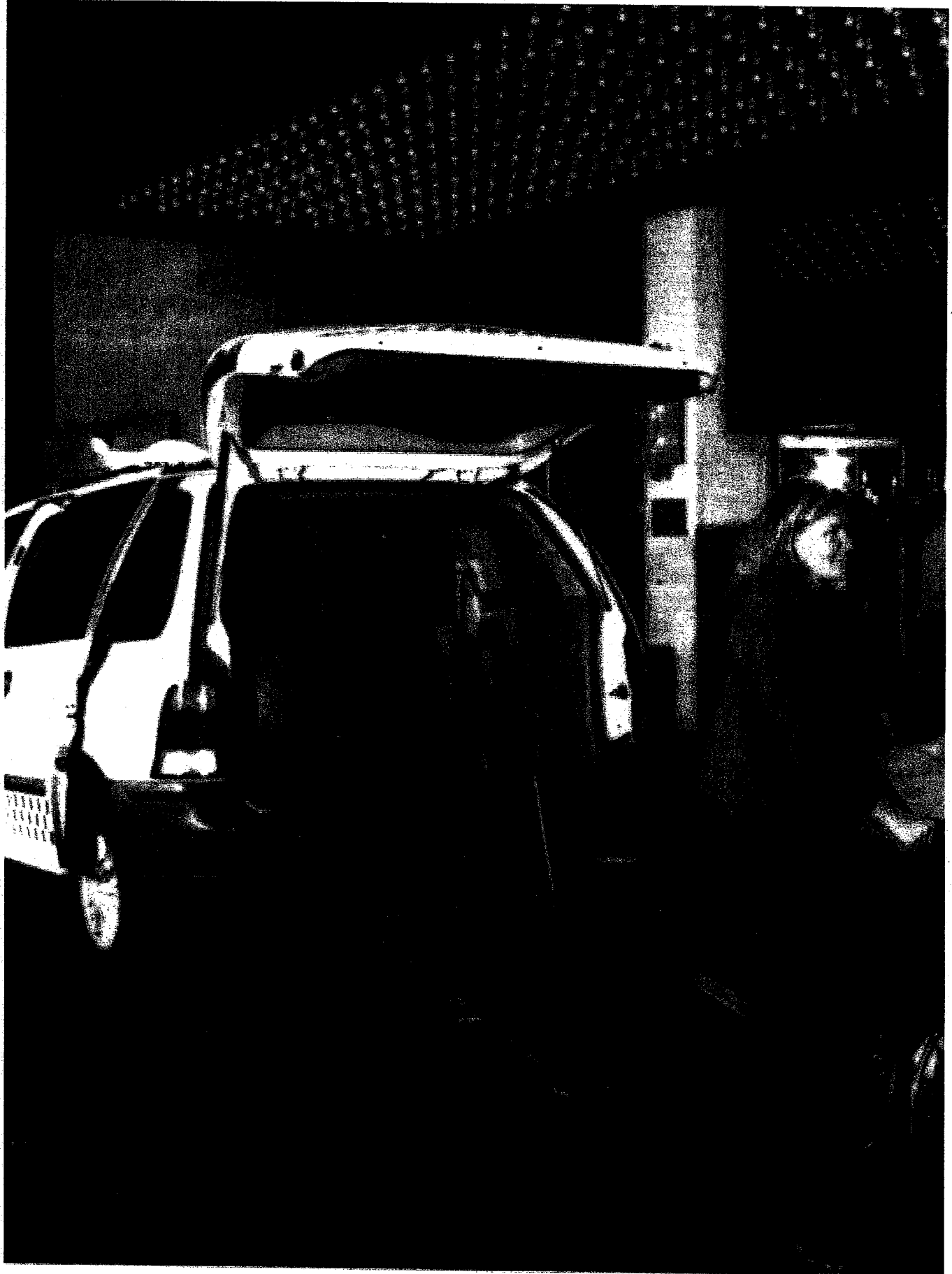

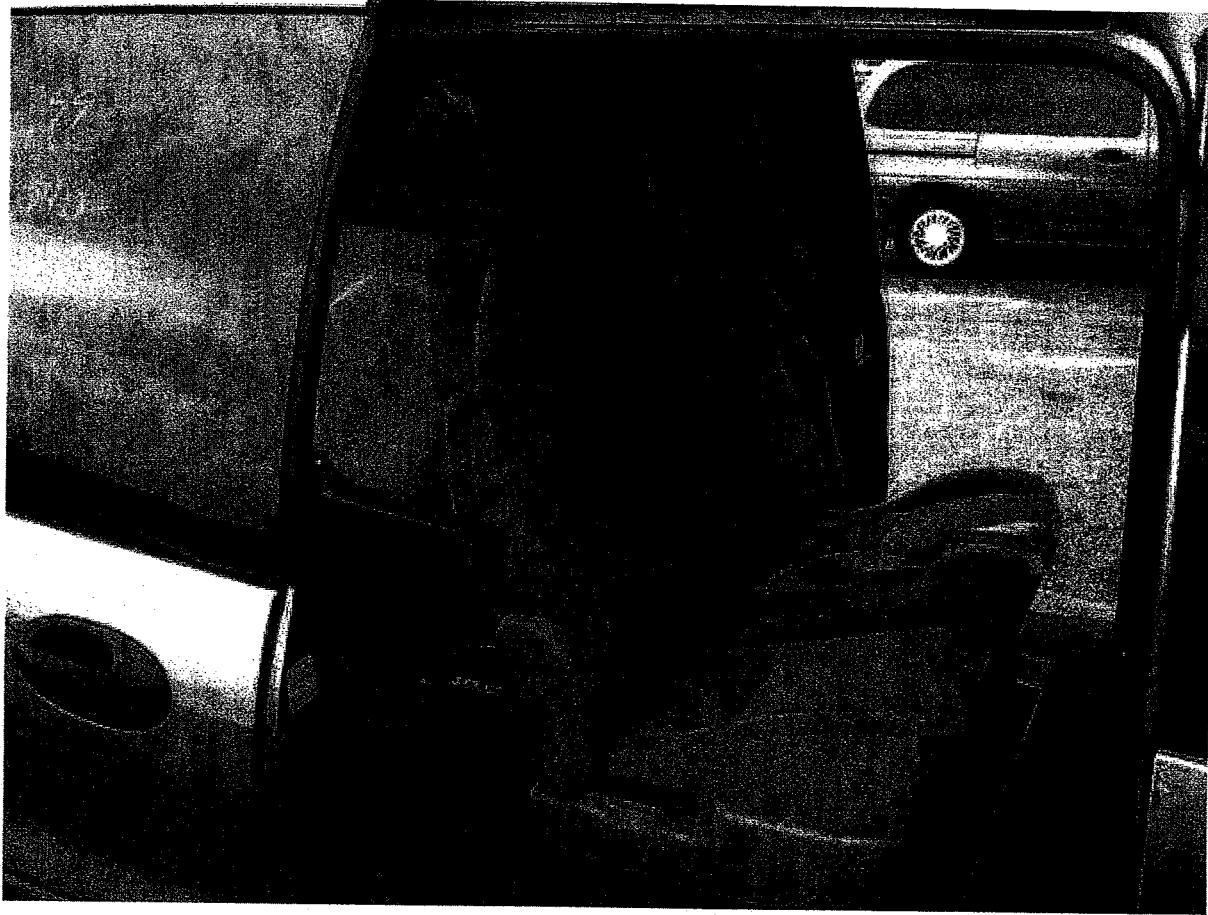
As per the Chapter 100 ordinance, my request today is that the Committee approve the color white for Yellow Cab of Milwaukee, Inc.

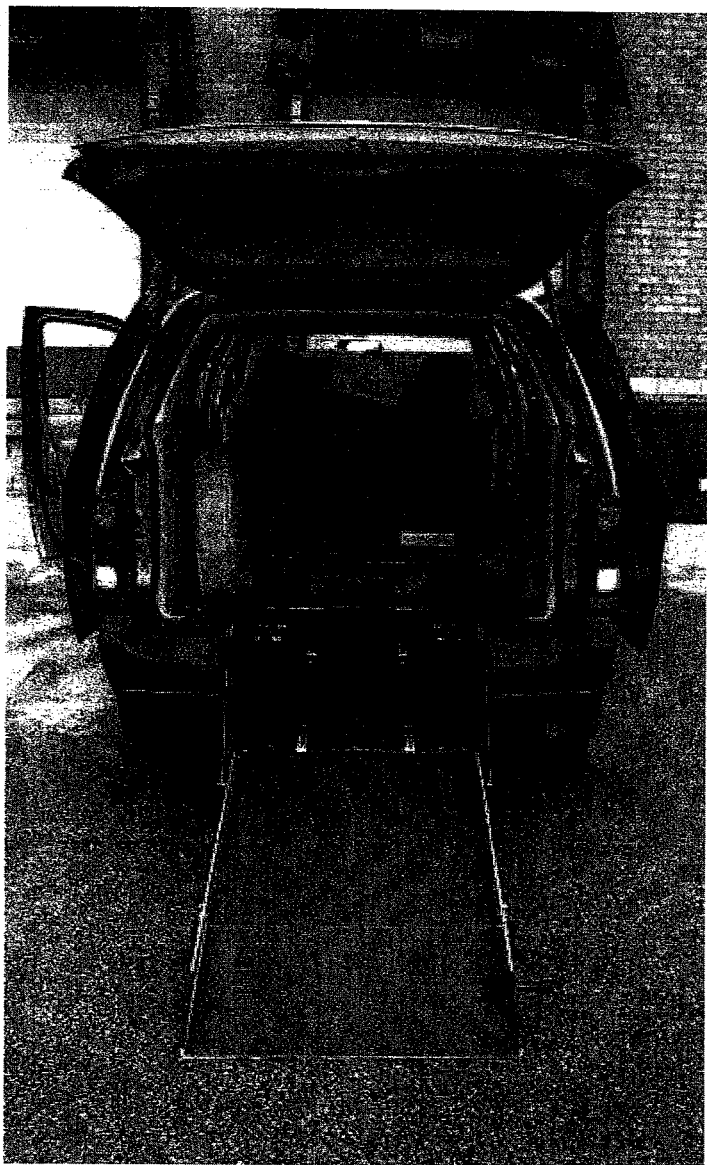

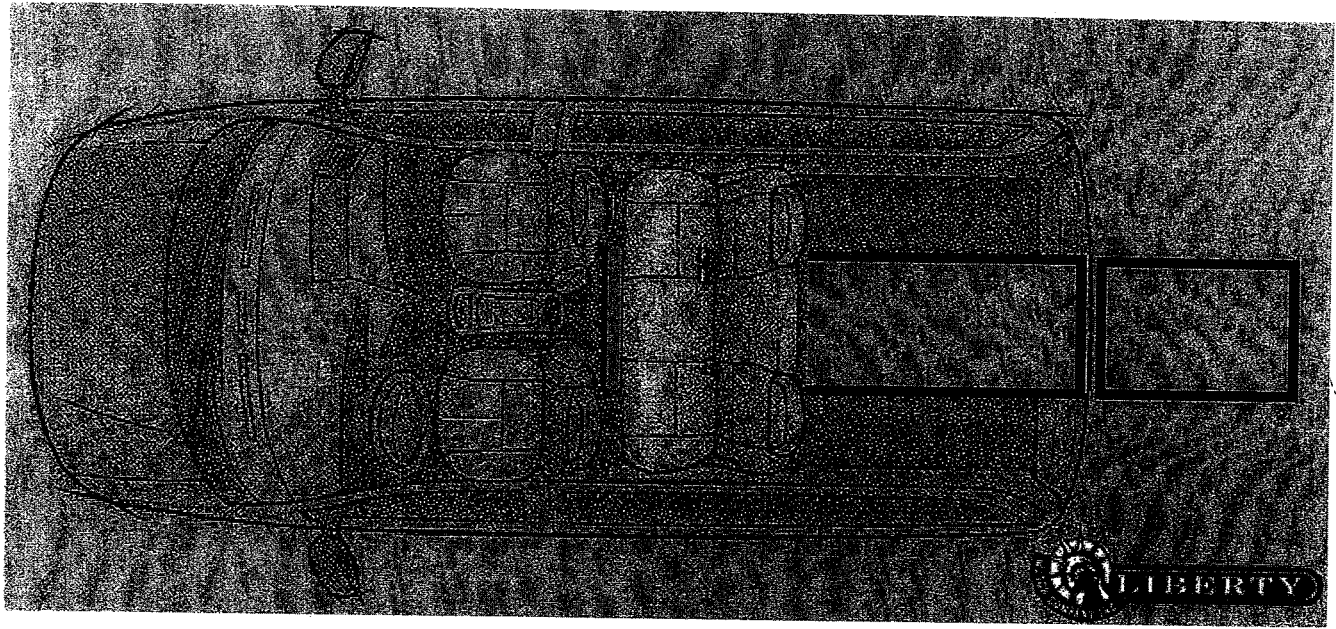


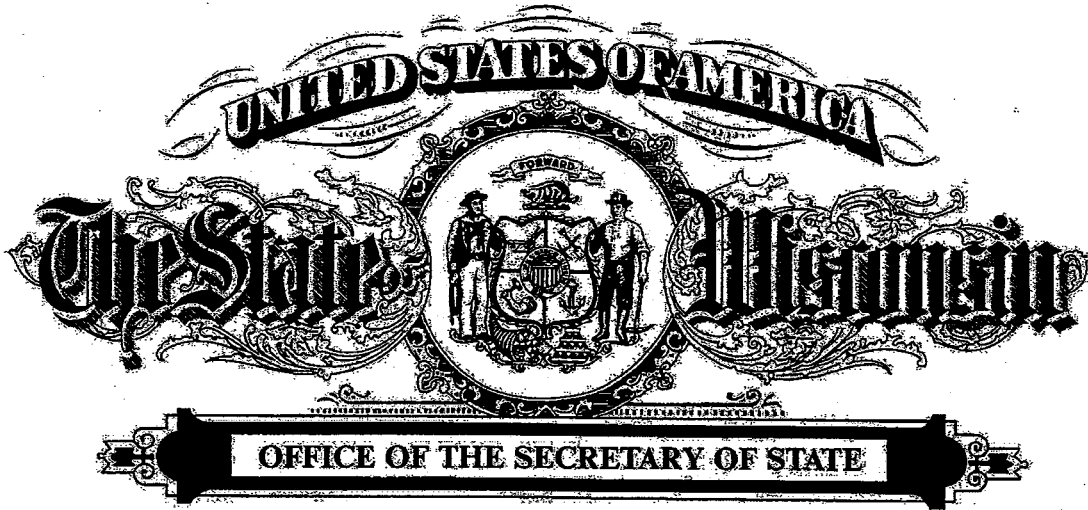
