File #070620 is a resolution relating to the expenditure of funds to be reimbursed by greater than anticipated revenue.

Background

- The Firemen's Relief Fund Special Purpose Account is utilized to help defray the
 costs of the Fire Department Relief Association, established under Section 20-18 of
 the City Charter. The City of Milwaukee is annually required to pay the Fire
 Department Relief Association 1/8 of the amount of the State Aids for Fire Insurance
 Premiums ("Fire Dues").
- 2. The City Fire Department Relief Association provides members death benefits. The members are active and retired Fire Department employees.
- 3. The funds received by the association through the Firemen's Relief Fund Special Purpose Account are invested in equities and fixed-income securities until distributed to beneficiaries.
- 4. The 2007 budgeted appropriation for this SPA is \$117,000.
- 5. Section 304-91 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances establishes procedural guidelines related to the expenditure of funds to be reimbursed by greater than anticipated revenues.

Discussion

- 1. The Comptroller has certified that greater than anticipated revenue in the amount of \$10,774.97, pursuant to s. 304-91 of the Code.
- 2. The fire insurance premiums received from the State were higher than appropriated in the 2007 Budget; the City's 2007 appropriation was based on prior year's experience. The amount of funding required by the City Charter is \$127,774.97 This is \$10,774.97 more than the \$117,000 appropriated for this purpose in 2007 Budget.

Fiscal Impact

The resolution authorizes the supplemental an increase of \$10,774.97 to the appropriations in the Firemen's Relief Fund SPA as required by the City Charter (s.20.18-2).
