REASON FOR REQUEST:

Paul Marchese, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and on foot patrol in the Sherman Park neighborhood at the approximate address of 5165 N. Sherman Boulevard. The uninsured motorist, who was travelling southbound on North Sherman Boulevard, lost control of his vehicle and went onto the sidewalk striking the claimant, causing him to go up onto the car's hood. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. §62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Marchese sustained injuries to his neck, low back, right hand, right wrist and right shoulder. The treating physician indicated that the right shoulder injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$76,461.45.
