- 3. On 05/04/2008 at 2:25pm Milwaukee Police were flagged down regarding a subject with a gun complaint at 2672 N. 35th Street (Alliance Super Food Market). Investigation revealed an armed robbery-pretend weapon had occurred inside the store. Nothing was obtained, there were no injuries and the applicant co-operated with the police during the investigation. - 5. On 03/14/11 at 7:46 pm, Milwaukee police were conducting sales of alcohol to underage persons and had a Milwaukee police enter 2672 N 35th Street in attempts to purchase alcohol. The aide was able to buy a 6 pack of Heineken beer in 12 oz bottles without being asked to provide ID. The clerk was identified as Riyad Salem and both Salem and the licensee, Farhud Khaled were cited for this violation.



A nurse turned over the victim's clothing and money to a detective who counted \$274.00 in currency with an odor of marijuana emanating from it. - 13. On 01/02/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a suspicious person/auto at 2672 North 35th Street (Alliance Super Food Market). Several subjects were loitering outside the business. - 14. On 03/02/2016 a reliable citizen informant described two subjects who were selling marijuana in the parking lot of Alliance Super Food Market (2672 North 35th Street). These subjects were detained and marijuana was recovered. Milwaukee police incident report #160620092 filed.
- 15. On 03/27/2016 officers observed a drug transaction in the parking lot of Alliance Super Food Market (2672 North 35th Street). Marijuana was recovered and a subject was arrested for delivery of a controlled substance. Milwaukee police incident report #160870087 filed.

Investigation revealed the victim was shot in the abdomen in the parking lot of Alliance Super Food Market (2672 North 35th Street) while he was being robbed.
