This business is currently open and operating. The business is in NUSIANCE STAUS and BILLING STATUS.

There is a sloppy hand written one NO Loitering scribble on the outside of the building.

The new owner will not be on sight. The current owner will be running the business.

The video is only kept for a week or two.

They did not have the tobacco license posted during our survey. It was not on premise.

The occupancy was also not posted. It was not on premise.



3. On 05/04/2008 at 2:25pm Milwaukee Police were flagged down regarding a subject with a gun complaint at 2672 N. 35<sup>th</sup> Street (Alliance Super Food Market). Investigation revealed an armed robbery-pretend weapon had occurred inside the store. Nothing was obtained, there were no injuries and the applicant co-operated with the police during the investigation. A subject was arrested regarding this offense and subsequently convicted of Theft of Movable Property. Incident report #081250113 filed.

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4. On 11/14/10 at 6:45 pm, Milwaukee police were investigating a complaint that involved a subject selling pirated DVD's inside 2672 N 35<sup>th</sup> Street, Alliance Foods. Officers arrested the subject who was selling the DVD's and spoke with Farhud Khaled, owner of the store. Khaled stated he allowed the subject to sell the DVD's inside and that he didn't know it was illegal. Police spoke with the subject who stated he was allowed to sell the DVD's inside the store by Khaled in exchange for unpaid help he provided which consisted of cutting meat, stocking displays and providing security for the store.

5. On 03/14/11 at 7:46 pm, Milwaukee police were conducting sales of alcohol to underage persons and had a Milwaukee police enter 2672 N 35<sup>th</sup> Street in attempts to purchase alcohol. The aide was able to buy a 6 pack of Heineken beer in 12 oz bottles without being asked to provide ID. The clerk was identified as Riyadh Salem and both Salem and the licensee, Farhud Khaled were cited for this violation.

This subject had been warned earlier in the day not to loiter in front of the store. The subject was arrested and issued a citation for Loitering.
10. On 05/17/2013 Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2672 North 35<sup>th</sup> Street (Alliance Food Market) for a Trouble with a Subject complaint. The applicant told police that a female subject had been inside the store creating a disturbance by shouting obscenities as well as other behavior causing the applicant to call police. 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
