

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Frank Vrtochnick, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee squad car that was parked facing northbound on West Windlake Avenue near the intersection with South 18<sup>th</sup> Street. The uninsured motorist, Juan Carlos Alvarado, was travelling southbound, in the wrong lane, on West Windlake Avenue and was on a path to collide with the City vehicle. In an attempt to avoid the imminent collision, Officer Vrtochnick tried to exit the City vehicle when he and the squad car were struck by the uninsured motorist. The uninsured motorist was convicted of two felonies (1<sup>st</sup> degree reckless injury and 1<sup>st</sup> degree recklessly endangering safety) and sentenced to six years in prison. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Vrtochnick sustained permanent injuries to his left ankle, left knee, and left elbow. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$623,422.79.
