Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

Please accept this letter as a timely filed written objection to the report of the license committee concerning Side Pocket Sports Bar located at 9316 West Appleton Avenue, City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Specifically, finding of fact 5H references a drug deal seen prior to the shooting. Mr. Strege objects to this reference as it was not a basis in Alderman Davis' complaint and was not reasonably related to Side Pocket Sports Bar. Furthermore, Mr. Strege objects to the recommendation of a revocation of the Tavern Dance license and a ninety (90) day suspension of the liquor license. Finally, Mr. Streqe objects to the suspension being effective July 31, 2007. In the even any punitive action is taken by the City Council, Mr. Strege would like 72 hours in order to request a Circuit Court injunction precluding any shutdown of his operation during the pendency of a Circuit Court appeal.
