Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that currently there are loading docks located on the south side of the street, and when large trucks are loading at the docks and vehicles are parked on the north side of the street, vehicular access is reduced. We, therefore, recommend the installation of the above-captioned parking restriction that would provide two-way traffic flow.
