

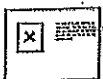

I have discovered an issue in your district that is a cause for concern. I have found out a tavern in your district employs a bartender who is currently facing charges for a 3rd OWI in less than 2 years.

My issue is not with the business itself, but the employee.

I'm upset that anyone with more than 1 OWI is allowed to maintain a City of Milwaukee bartender license.

I would hope you or your colleagues who issue and renew these licenses would be aware of these issues and address them accordingly.
