He states that this did cause Ms. HARMON to freeze, affording him the opportunity to place one cuff on her right wrist. He states however, Ms. HARMON continued to resist his efforts to handcuff her left hand and that she did continue to struggle until the arrival of additional officers. He states that an Officer David KUMBIER did assist him in handcuffing her left wrist. He states that Ms. HARMON was then escorted to an awaiting patrol wagon at which time her eyes were flushed with water.

Upon being conveyed to District #7 complainant Kimberly HARMON did submit to a breath test which revealed a reading of .168, as a result she was subsequently charged with Driving While Under the Influence of an Intoxicant, Driving with Prohibited Alcohol Content, Unreasonable and Imprudent Speed, Resisting/Obstructing an Officer and Seatbelt Violation (operator).

CONCLUSION:

On Tuesday, June 1, 1999 the office of the District Attorney did review the afore stated charges against Ms. HARMON. It was determined by ADA LOGSDON that citations relative to allegations of MS. HARMON Operating While Under the Influence would be issued. Further ADA LOGSDON declined to issue the charge of Resisting/Obstructing an Officer and recommended that Ms. HARMON be issued a city citation for Resisting.

This investigation did not reveal any wrong doing on the part of P.O. Mark WAGNER, therefore this incident will be cleared as baseless.
