Build it safely – for motorists

Special emphasis on work zone safety in conjunction with Milwaukee Co Sheriff

- Traffic response units to clear incidents quickly
- Regular traffic control inspections











Build it safely – for workers

- Project uses Owner Controlled Insurance Policy (OCIP) with Safety Program
 - ◆ Drug testing / screening
 - ♦ Worker orientation and training
 - ◆ On-site safety directors
 - On-site medical trailer fully staffed by trained paramedic
 - ◆ Regular safety inspections with fines levied for non-compliance

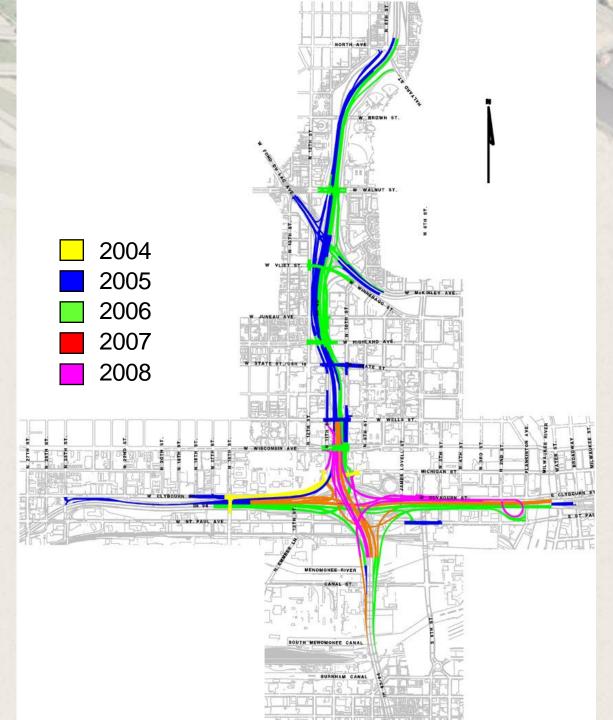

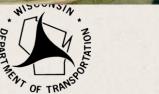

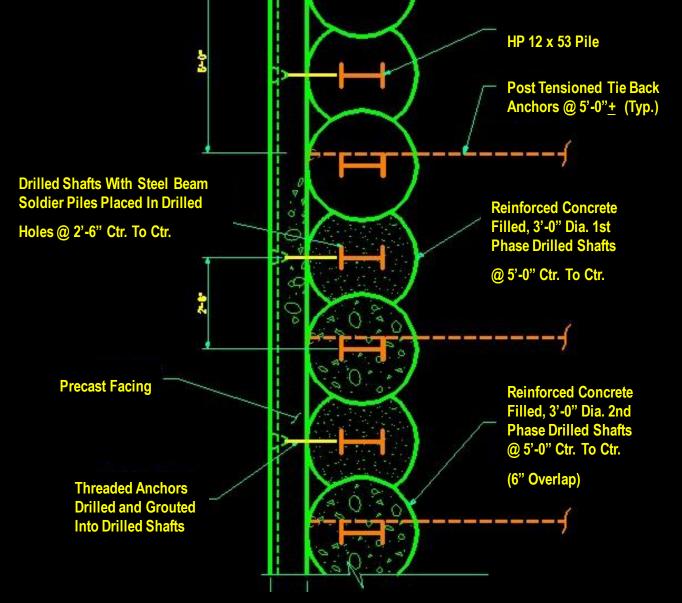
