1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The purpose of the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant is to enhance the security and overall preparedness to prevent, respond to, and recover from terrorism in a multi-jurisdictional multi-discipline manner. The Milwaukee Urban Area identified by the Federal government for this grant includes Milwaukee, Waukesha, and Washington Counties, with the City of Milwaukee as the lead and fiscal agent.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

City of Milwaukee Strategic Plan:

Strategic Goal: Protect Milwaukee's citizens from crime, fires, and other hazards

As part of the UASI grant, the Milwaukee Urban Area was required to write an Urban Area strategy. The goals identified through this process include:

- 1) Improve Interoperable Communications
- 2) Reinforce Incident Command System
- 3) Increase Multidisciplinary, All Hazards Response Capability and Identify Resources for Surge Capacity
- 4) Increase Capacity to Rapidly Identify Potential Threats
- 5) Increase Capabilities to Detect, Prevent, and Respond to Threats to Agricultural and Animal Health Incidents
- 6) Develop Plans to Protect Critical Facility Infrastructure, Public Safety Personnel and Essential Services

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

This grant will be used by City of Milwaukee departments (Police, Fire, Health and Mayor's Office) and Milwaukee, Waukesha and Washington Counties to address the goals identified by the Urban Area Working Group (see Item #2). This funding will augment local and grant funding in an effort to enhance the security and preparedness in the entire Urban Area.
