Re: **Opening a Communication File relative to requesting Common Council authorization to produce and distribute a Request for Proposals (RFP) for an FMIS (Financial Management Information Systems) Application Service Provider (ASP)**

Under Resolution #990089 as amended by Resolution #020756, a department requesting authorization from the Common Council to explore outsourcing must prepare a written report specifying the service or functions to be outsourced and the substantiating reasons therefor.

This is to request that a Communication file be opened for the above purpose, sponsored by the Department of Administration (DOA). DOA-ITMD has been studying issues relating to the outsourcing of FMIS for several months, and wishes to create an RFP to test the market for services that include outsourcing of hardware and operating systems, as well as assistance with running and maintaining the PeopleSoft application programs that comprise the City's FMIS systems.

We are creating a written report per the Council resolution and would appreciate the opportunity to present this report to the appropriate Committees as soon as is practical. The objective would be to acquire Council approval to issue the RFP via a separate companion Common Council resolution.
