Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 000965, being a petition from Vulcan Technologies Leasing Company for a special privilege to allow a fence to encroach into the public right-of-way of the east-west public alley in the block bounded by South Barclay Street, East Florida Street, East Pittsburgh Avenue and South Water Street, adjacent to the property at 221 East Oregon Street.

Our field investigation revealed that the 7-foot high chain link fence had been constructed in a skewed fashion in the right-of-way located at the northwest corner of the 20-foot wide deadend alley. The fence has barbed wire on top. It appears that the fence had been placed to prevent access to the rear of the property at 221 East Oregon Street.

We do not believe that the installation of the fence in the public right-of-way will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way at this location. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow the fence to occupy the public right-of-way.
