This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/10/2017 officers were dispatched to La Caleta, 1801 S Muskego Av, for a theft complaint. A suspect grabbed an employee's phone and ran out of the business. The business was very cooperative with the police.

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2. On 03/04/2018 officers were dispatched to a fight at La Caleta, 1801 S Muskego Av. The investigation revealed a fight on the dance floor between three subjects that security broke up using pepper spray. The officer observed that the posted licenses were expired. The applicant was on scene and stated the new licenses were at her home. The officers observed the video surveillance and issued a citation to one subject for Disorderly Conduct.
3. On 03/11/2018 officers were dispatched to a battery complaint at La Caleta, 1801 S Muskego Av. The officers interviewed an intoxicated subject who stated security had dragged him out of the bar and assaulted him. The officers interviewed security who stated the subject was attempting to fight other patrons and threatened to kill the security officer. When the security officers were escorting the subject out he hit one to the face. The security officer then hit the subject back. The subject was issued a citation for Disorderly Conduct and Battery. While checking the tavern the officers observed the posted license was expired. The applicant was issued a citation for Display of License- Posting required.

4. On 03/20/2018 officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject complaint at La Caleta, 1801 S. Muskego Av. The applicant was on scene and had called regarding a subject who had been banned from the tavern that was refusing to leave. The subject left prior to the officer arrival. No violations were observed.
5. On 09/08/2018 at 10:41pm officers were dispatched to a subject with gun complaint at 1801 S Muskego Av. The officers interviewed several patrons who stated they were sprayed in the face with O.C. Spray by a security guard for not reason. The security guard stated he sprayed them as they were charging toward him. The incident was advised on that night because the officers could not view the video surveillance. On 09/10/2018 the officers contacted the applicant and were able to view the video. The video did show the security guard spraying subjects by the door but did not show any of the confrontation outside. The video showed there were inconsistencies with the stories of all parties.
6. On 10/03/2018 officers were dispatched to a battery complaint at La Caleta bar, 1801 S Muskego Av. The officers interviewed the victim who stated she got into a verbal argument with a female that was talking with the victim's husband. The fight turned physical with the subject punching the victim to the face. The suspect then fled the scene. The officers spoke with the applicant who stated the suspect was a former employee but had none of the suspect's information.

8. On 05/13/2011 Omar MONREAL SALAS (50% shareholder) was cited for Operating while Intoxicated. He was convicted on 06/12/2011 and his license was revoked for 6 months. This item added as part of a change in ownership.

9. On 10/31/20 at 1:44am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an armed robbery which occurred near the address of 1801 S. Muskego Avenue. Investigation revealed that a patron left the tavern, was walking to his vehicle, and was beaten/robbed. When the victim walked back to the tavern to get help, security asked him to leave and they closed the door on him. Contact was made with the security guard outside the tavern and he stated that no incident(s) happened inside the tavern.

10. On 03/27/21 at 2:17am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 S. Muskego Avenue for a fight complaint. Investigation revealed that two subjects were battered by a group of six subjects and one victim received sutures. The fight happened inside the tavern and the victims did not know why they were attacked.
11. On 04/02/21 at 11:32pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 W. Muskego Avenue for a shooting complaint. Investigation revealed that two groups of patrons inside the establishment engage in a verbal argument inside the bathroom. An employee entered the bathroom and told the patrons to disperse. While one of the groups were entering their vehicle, another vehicle approached and shot three people. The owner and bartender were cooperative with police and allowed them to review surveillance footage.
12. On 04/19/21 an 80-10 Nuisance Designation was drafted for nuisance activity at 1801 S. Muskego Avenue and the letter was mailed to the building owner.
13. On 05/04/21 at 8:00pm, Milwaukee Police, along with Wisconsin Department of Revenue Agents, conducted a license premise check at 1801 S. Muskego Avenue. When officers arrived, they observed an unlicensed bartender at the bar portion of the premise and the applicant in the restaurant portion. During the check, the applicant could not provide an invoice for any of the beer or liquor on the premise. The agents confiscated 62 liquor bottles and 65 boxes of beer.
14. On 05/18/21 at 10:00am, Members of the Milwaukee Police Department, City Attorney's Office, and a member of Safe and Sound, had a meeting with the members representing the business located at 1801 S. Muskego Avenue. The meeting was to discuss the Nuisance Designation put on the business and the abatement plan the business proposed. The abatement plan was denied because it did not address calling for police services, not training employees, not checking for weapons, and not preventing loitering outside the premise. The Captain of the Second District stated that a new plan would be considered if presented within ten business.

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15. On 05/27/21 at 1:43am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 S. Muskego Avenue for a shots fired complaint. Officers were unable to find the complainant and no evidence recovered.
16. On 05/30/21 at 2:44am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 S. Muskego Avenue for a ShotSpotter complaint. Investigation revealed that the officers advised the caller and no evidence was found.
17. On 06/06/21 at 2:00am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 S. Muskego Avenue for a ShotSpotter complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject was walking by the tavern and discharged a firearm into the air. Four spent casings were found and the applicant did not call the police to report the incident.
18. On 06/13/21 at 1:11am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 S. Muskego Avenue for a ShotSpotter complaint. Officers were unable to find the complainant and no evidence recovered.

19. On 07/24/21 at 10:08pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 S. Muskego Avenue for a ShotSpotter compliant. Officers were unable to find the complainant and no evidence recovered.
20. On 10/18/21 at 2:08am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1801 S. Muskego Avenue for a ShotSpotter compliant. Officers were unable to find the complainant and no evidence recovered.
21. On 01/17/22 at 2:05pm, a subject walked into the Second District Police Station to report a battery which occurred at 1801 S. Muskego Avenue on 01/16/22. A surveillance camera revealed that the subject who was reporting the battery started the altercation with another subject and had to be separated by a third party.
22. On 02/03/22 at 2:00pm, a meeting was held at the Second District Police Station with the applicant of 1801 S. Muskego Avenue and representatives of the City of Milwaukee. The meeting was held to discuss the current operation of the tavern. The applicant told representatives that they have purchased the building they conduct business in, removed the problem tenants who live above the establishment, hired a new security service, and have painted the building to help with the aesthetic of the neighborhood.

this establishment, was reported by the below listed subject, but it was never reported or called in by the Manager on duty. No further investigation was conducted to the assault allegations as they are unfounded. I inventoried the video of the incident. Further follow-up can be conducted by the District Tavern Car or C.P.U, unit.

*******BASELESS COMPLAINT - NO VICTIMS*******

This report is submitted by Police Officer Michael DEDERICH, assigned to District Two, Day Shift. On Monday, January 17th, 2022, at 2:05 P.M., while assigned to the duties of the Desk P.O., I was approached at the front counter by a subject who indicated that he wanted to report that he was advised by his lawyer to come to the district. I was assisted in this investigation by Police Officer Eilel CONTRERAS as translator. I asked the subject, later identified with a Mexico Consular I.D. card as **Gaspar GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO W/M (H) 4-18-81**, what he wanted to report and he stated that he went to a restaurant at approximately 12:30 P.M. on Sunday, January 16th, 2022 to pick up food and he was struck on the forehead with a bottle. GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO stated that he wanted to report this to the police because the person who has a restraining order on him was also at the restaurant. I asked GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO why he was at this restaurant and he stated that he was there just to pick up food and he goes there from time to time. I asked **GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO** if he noticed the (Petitioner) identified as **Maria De Jesus ARIAS-GUTIERREZ W/F (H) 6-18-71**, and he stated that he didn't realize she was there. **GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO** stated that he was hit on his forehead with a bottle then later showed me his forehead but I did not see any injury consistent with his accusations nor did he make a complaint of pain. P.O. CONTRERAS and I found out that the restaurant location was actually the La Caleta Restaurant located at 1810 S. Muskego St., an address located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Police Officer ELM and SCHMITZ conducted follow-up at this location and obtained video of the actual event. I inventoried this video (Inventory #22002077).

The video depicts **GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO** approaching a male subject in an angry fashion and swinging an open palm hand striking him in the face. This subject appears to be the subject **GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO** described as the "suspect." The video continues as **GONZALEZ-SANTIAGO** attempts to overwhelm this subject by repeatedly swinging and striking the persons face and body. The video does show a bottle in the hand of the subject as he reacts assumingly in a reactive swing. I checked the address for **ARIAS-GUTIERREZ** as well as 1810 S. Muskego St. for any counter complaints and I did not see any listed. There is a female subject in this video separating both male subjects and I believe this subject to be **ARIAS-GUTIERREZ**.

I saved a copy of the actual fight on my personal N drive as well. I will keep a working copy at the district.

MONREAL (w/m, 1-30-82), Alderwoman ZAMARRIPA, Captain Patrick PAJOT, PO Kevin VODICKA, and myself. The meeting was held to discuss the current operation of the tavern, and some of the past nuisance activities that have occurred at the premise. Discussed was the amount of previously reported Shotspotter calls tied to the bar's address, and ways to improve operations of the tavern to encourage more of positive impact in the surrounding community. GASPAR and MONREAL recently purchased the building in May of 2021, instead of being renters, tying them more to the community. GASPAR and MONREAL also have 4 rental units above the bar, and have moved out the problem tenants that were responsible for some of the nuisance activities that occurred at the premise. During their suspension they painted the outside of the building, and remodeled the inside, improving the overall aesthetic. They also stated that they had some problems with their last contracted security guards, and have since hired a new company January 1, 2022, and will go over their expectations with the security staff to ensure cooperation with police. GASPAR and MONREAL were also advised to come up with a written safety plan that documents their improvements to the building and how they plan on safely managing the tavern moving forward.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
