

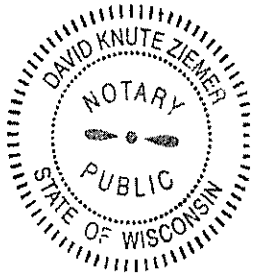

Substitute resolution approving levy-
ing of assessments and construction of
assessable public improvement projects
at various locations and appropriating
funds for these purposes with the City
cost of these projects approved by this
resolution is estimated to be \$80,000
for a total estimated cost of \$91,000.

Whereas, The Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee adopted prelimi-
nary resolutions, determining it neces-
sary and in the public interest to con-
struct and levy special assessments for
the following improvements:

10th Aldermanic District
N. 58th St.- A. paint south of W. Val-
ley Forge Dr. to W. Valley Forge Dr.
(ST211110105) File Number: 100142. As-
phalt pavement resurfacing, replace all
curb and gutter, replace sidewalk and
driveway approaches where neces-
sary, sodding (6.0-foot width of tree
border area), and grading. (Assessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$7,000;
Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving
Fund - \$73,000). The total estimated
cost for this project including the re-
quested amount is \$91,000. This project
is anticipated to be completed during
the 2010 construction season.

Whereas, The report of the Commis-
sioner of Public Works has been filed
with the City Clerk; and

Whereas, Notices have been sent to
all interested persons and public hear-
ings held; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee, that the Com-
missioner of Public Works' Report, as
amended at said Public Hearing, is ap-
proved and the properties therein iden-
tified are benefited; and, be it

Further Resolved, That said Commis-
sioner of Public Works is authorized
and directed to proceed with said work
in accordance with said report pursuant
to Section 66.0703 and any other per-
tinent sections of the Wisconsin Stat-
utes and in the manner directed by Sec-
tion 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of
Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper
departments take such action as is re-
quired of them to assess the abutting or
adjacent properties and collect such as-
sessment in the manner directed by Sec-
tion 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of
Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City
Comptroller is authorized and directed
to transfer such funds which are avail-
able for this purpose to the appropriate
capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be
it

Further Resolved, That the projects
do not involve any parcels of agricul-
tural land which are eligible for de-
ferred special assessments under the
provisions of Section 14.30 of the Mil-
waukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Depart-
ment of Public Works is authorized to
use the funding as specified in the
above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That project N.
58th St. (ST211110105) will be billed af-
ter January 1, 2012, but not before 12
months after the project contract has
been completed.
