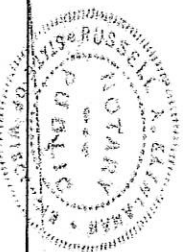

a point 1,600 feet west of N.
Teutonia Ave. (ST211160107) File
Number 151746: Asphalt pavement
resurfacing; replace curb and gutter,

sidewalk and driveway approaches
where necessary, sodding (9-foot
width of tree border area), and
grading. (Assessable Reconstruction
Paving Fund -- \$50,000; Nonasses-
sable Reconstruction Paving Fund --
\$165,000). The total estimated cost
for this project including the
requested amount is \$245,000. This
project is anticipated to be
completed during the 2016 construc-
tion season.

8th Aldermanic District
W. Mitchell St. - S. 38th St. to
Miller Park Way (Portions in the
Village of West Milwaukee)
(ST211150143) File Number
131733: Asphalt pavement
resurfacing; replace curb and gutter,
sidewalk and driveway approaches
where necessary, sodding, and
grading. (Assessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund --
\$20,000; Nonassessable Recon-
struction Paving Fund -- \$125,000;
ST214160101 Developer/West
Milwaukee -- \$90,000). The total
