This is to notify you that on Tuesday, June 21, 2016, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council Renewal, with a thirty (30) days suspension of the Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and Public Entertainment Premises licenses for the premises located at 2537 W National Ave ("Candelas") based on the police report, and aldermanic and applicant testimony.

On June 23, 2016, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the renewal applications for the Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and Public Entertainment Premises licenses in which the Committee recommended that the licenses be suspended for thirty (30) days. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Wednesday, July 6, 2016, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did appear, and you did file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to suspend for thirty (30) days the Class B Tavern, Food Dealer, and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based on the police report, and aldermanic and applicant testimony. Said suspension will be in effect between July 6, 2016 through 11:59 p.m. August 4, 2016.






