If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

During the inspection, Liquor, an open pack of cigarettes, and Quest cards were all found behind the front counter. The employee told officers/agents that the liquor belonged to another employee whose wife will not allow him to drink at home, so he drank after work. The open pack of cigarettes belonged to an employee that was not working and the Quest cards had been left by various customers. The employee was told that he cannot keep other people's Quest cards, cannot sell single cigarettes, and cannot have liquor on the premise. The liquor was seized and the license premise check was concluded.

On Monday, August 20th, 2018, The CLO/CPU Unit of District 7, met with the ownership of "Kool Petroleum".

This was the first meting of two meetings that were coordinated to address the pornographic video that had been filmed inside the business during business hours.

"Kool Petroleum" is located at 3381 N. 35th St.

The video in question is that of Frederick ALLEN (M/B, 01/24/93) having intercourse in the aisle of the filling station with an unknown female.

In the video, which had been posted to "Pornhub", employees can be seen watching the incident from behind the counter. There did not appear to be an effort to stop the incident.

Present at the meeting were PO BUCHNER, Sgt. ROSS, Sgt. RADEN, Assistant City Attorney Savion GRENELL, Kulwanat DHILLON (owner) and his attorneys.

At the meeting, DHILLON confirmed the video had been recorded at his establishment. DHILLON stated he would cooperate with police in the effort to determine when the incident occurred and which employee(s) were present.

No further communication(s) from DHILLON came after the meeting.

During the meeting, DHILLON stated he would supply the names of the employee(s) that were present at the time of the incident. Also, DHILLON agreed to cooperate and assist police in obtaining whatever surveillance video was available at the time of the pornographic recording.

District 7 CLO/CPU office contacted Sgt. Chad RADEN (License Investigation Unit) as well as Alderman Khalif RAINEY in regards to the incident, which occurred within the 7th Aldermanic District of the City of Milwaukee.

Following the meeting, DHILLON was not cooperative in providing police with the further information that had been agreed upon.

This report was written by P.O. Bowie Buchner, assigned to district seven, early power shift.

On Wednesday January 16, 2019 I responded with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue to conduct a check at Kool Pertoleum, located at 3381 N. 35th St. Upon arrival we spoke with Baljinder SINGH, who was the clerk working at the time of the inspection. SINGH was very cooperative with officers and agents on scene. During the inspection liquor was found in the area behind the counter. Two sealed bottles of liquor, one sealed bottle of wine, and one opened bottle of liquor was found. The opened bottle was also missing some of the liquor inside the bottle. When asked SINGH stated that all the liquor belonged to one of the employees, who was not on scene. SINGH explained that this employee's wife does not allow him to drink or keep alcohol in the house. Therefore, the employee keeps his liquor at the store and will sometimes drink after his shift. It was explained to SINGH that this location does not have a liquor license and can not sell liquor. SINGH stated that they did not sell liquor and again said it belonged to one of the employees for personal use. Agents also discovered quest cards behind the counter. When asked SINGH stated that those where cards that had been left by customers. Agents advised SINGH that the employees cannot keep individuals cards at the store. Lastly, a an opened pack of cigarettes with some missing from the pack was located behind the counter. When asked about the cigarettes SINGH stated that they belonged to an employee that was not at the store at the time. SINGH also stated that they never sell single cigarettes. Agents seized the alcohol and advised SINGH that citations may be issued regarding the selling of alcohol or the selling of single cigarettes.



Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.




Activities I have many more pictures too many.


Businesses bringing in dangerous people to the community especially in the school zone should be elsewhere not across from a high school.


I am sure I have left much out but see the pictures.



This report is written by PO Penny MONREAL, assigned to the License Investigation Unit.

On Thursday, July 25, 2019, PO Denise RUEDA and I conducted a license premise check at Piercings Plus, located at 4112 W. Center St. This was in regards from a citizen complaint they were operating without a Tattoo/Body Piercing License.

On arrival officers found the "Open" sign to be illuminated, however, the door to the business was locked. The agent/owner, Willie L. SZULCZEWSKI B/M 05/31/73, did unlock the door and officers inside. There were no customers inside the business, however, I observed the trash cans to be full. SZULCZEWSKI denied being open for business, and stated he did apply for a license with the City, and was waiting for the Health Department to conduct their inspection. SZULCZEWSKI provided me with a license from the State Department of Safety and Professional Services (279-404) which was valid until 06/30/20 as well as a valid Occupancy Permit. SZULCZEWSKI stated he knew who called the police and when he saw her he was going to "whip her the finger and let her know he didn't like her". SZULCZEWSKI was advised this was not a good beginning to having a positive relationship with his neighbors and strongly advised he should attempt to get a long with his neighbors, in order to be a positive business in the community. I advised SZULCZEWSKI that I would be conducting follow up regarding his application with the City.

A check with LIRA (License Information Reporting and Administration) revealed SZULCZEWSKI had not applied for a license. I contacted SZULCZEWSKI via the telephone to advise him of the same, at which time SZULCZEWSKI became very argumentative, insisting he did apply. I also advised SZULCZEWSKI that I found multiple Google Reviews on the business as recent as a month ago and inquired as to how this could be possible, if he weren't open for business. SZULCZEWSKI stated he created the account, however, continued to deny he was open for business.

I checked for a Facebook account for Piercings Plus, and did in fact locate one, which depicted numerous pictures of specials offered during the month of July, as well as the business address of 4112 W. Center St. There were also multiple pictures and video of customers with body piercings and tattoos, as well as a picture of SZULCZEWSKI. Based on this investigation I determined SZULCZEWSKI is operating without a Tattoo Body Piercing license and a citation was issued.



Dear Mr. Szulczewski;

We are pleased to confirm our firm's engagement to represent you in the above-referenced matter. Below please find the terms that shall govern our representation of you as required by the State Bar of Wisconsin:

Maistelman & Associates, LLC (hereinafter "Attorney"), is engaged to represent Mr. Willie Lee Szulczewski and Piercings Plus, LLC (collectively hereinafter "Client") in connection with the above-referenced matter. Attorney may retain associate counsel, consultants, experts, accountants, or investigators to protect Client's interests. Fees charged by associate counsel, experts, or investigators retained by Attorney shall be treated as expenses to be paid by Client on demand by Attorney. Attorney will consult with Client before retaining outside counsel, experts, or investigators.

The scope of this representation may be changed only by written agreement between Attorney and Client. Client understands that any and all additional not listed herein will require fee agreement and separate payments by Client.

Client understands that this fee agreement includes representation for the services listed below only, under the terms and subject to the exclusions described below. Client further understands that this fee agreement does not include representation for any further proceedings or civil litigation beyond the scope described below, including but not limited to administrative or any other appeals.

Attorney's Fees

Attorney's fees for services performed under this agreement shall be divided into flat fee payments. Payments are refundable and will be placed directly into Attorney's business account upon receipt, and Client agrees that Attorney may so deposit the payments. The amount of the flat fee payments

are based on many factors, including the difficulty, number, and severity of the charges; Attorney's skill and reputation in handling matters such as yours; and the possibility that Attorney will be precluded from representing others due to a conflict of interest.

Additionally, and most significantly, if Attorney spends a greater than normal amount of time on this matter, Client will benefit from this flat fee agreement by not being billed beyond the flat fee payments outlined herein. Client understands that additional, unexpected time can be required of Attorney due to unexpected motions or legal research, and other unanticipated legal problems and issues. Under this flat fee agreement, however, Client benefits by not having to pay Attorney on an hourly basis.

Total Advanced Flat fee payment of \$1,500, not including any costs, and expenses incurred, is due at the time this agreement is signed. The flat fee shall be earned as follows:

\$500: Communicate with Client and review Client documentation;

\$500: Communicate with City of Milwaukee Licensing Office, Obtain and review City of Milwaukee File – Per Public Records Request, substantive case analysis; and

\$500: Liaise with City of Milwaukee officials and employees; in an attempt to obtain Alderman's, approval for license without having to go before Licensing Hearing.

The flat fee listed above does not include attending any Licensing Hearings or appealing any denials of the above-referenced License application. Should Client wish for Attorney to appeal and such denials or prepare for and attend a Licensing Hearing, Client will be billed an additional \$500 for the same.

Client agrees that failure to make payments in a timely manner, as set forth above, is grounds for Attorney's withdrawal from representation in this matter.

By law, Attorney must refund any unearned advanced fee, along with an accounting, at the termination of the representation. However, at the conclusion of the representation, all flat fee(s) paid by Client under this agreement will be earned. Client acknowledges that this fee agreement is based on refundable flat fees, not an hourly rate, in part so that Client may benefit from the certainty of one or two fixed amounts instead of taking the risk of hourly billing for unexpected research, lengthy motion practice, and other unanticipated Attorney hours. Under this refundable, flat fee agreement, the risk of these events is placed on Attorney rather than Client.

However, upon conclusion of the representation, if Client believes that a portion of the flat fees is unearned, Client should request a refund in writing. Attorney is required to submit any dispute about a requested refund of advanced fees to binding arbitration within 30 days of receiving a written request for such a refund.
