
Dear Mr. Hinton:

You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on July 31, 2007, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to consider the renewal of your Class "B" Tavern license application for the premises located at 2525 North Holton Street ("Montal's Lounge").
