

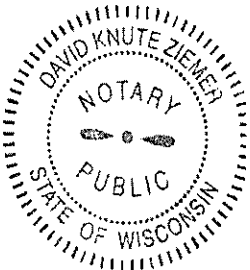

## City of Milwaukee Official Notice Published by Authority of the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee Office of the City Clerk 7/23/2010

I, Ronald D. Leonhardt, City Clerk of the City of Milwaukee, certify that pursuant to Section 4-06-3 of the Milwaukee City Charter, notice is given of the passage of the following ordinances by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee on 7/8/2010, with the approval of Mayor Tom Barrett. The full text of each of the ordinances listed below can be obtained at the Office of the City Clerk, Room 205, City Hall, 200 E. Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 53202.

**070789...** A substitute ordinance amending the definition of junk, establishing a fingerprinting requirement for junk collector and junk dealer license applicants, and prohibiting the purchase of junk from unlicensed junk collectors and junk dealers.

**100033...** A substitute ordinance relating to a change in zoning from General Planned Development to a Detailed Planned Development, known as Park Place Stage 29, for the new headquarters of Junior Achievement of Wisconsin, on lands located south of West Liberty Drive and east of West Park Place, in the 5th Aldermanic District.

**100036...** A substitute ordinance relating to a change in zoning from Local Business to Two-Family Residential to correct mixed zoning on the site, on land located east of North 1st Street and south of East North Avenue, in the 6th Aldermanic District.

**100206...** An ordinance relating to certain fees collected by the department of city development.

**100208...** A substitute ordinance requiring secondhand dealers to report transactions on a police-approved Internet website, standardizing identification requirements and lengthening holding periods for certain items.
