3. On 05/06/2017 at 2:30am officers observed a large group of cars parked in front of TJ's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av. At 2:40am the officers conducted a tavern check. The officers heard loud music coming from inside. The security guard unlocked the door and told everyone they had to leave. The officers counted 40 patrons leaving the bar. The manager was Kevine BARNETT and he did not understand why officers made contact with the tavern. The applicant was cited for Class B Premises Allow Patron after Hours.

- 4. On 06/24/2017 officers were dispatched to TJ's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av, for a fight. Upon arrival the officers were advised by security that one subject left and the other was in the parking lot. The officers observed the intoxicated subject in the parking lot refusing to leave. He was detained when he attempted to strike one of his friends.
- 5. On 01/01/2018 officers were dispatched to an Entry complaint at 2911 W. North Av. The officer was met by a security company that had an open front door. The officer searched the building and found nothing out of the ordinary. The investigation determined the employee had left the door unlocked when they left for the day.
- 6. On 05/28/2018 officers were dispatched to a Shotspotter call at 2929 W. North Av. The officers went to 2911 W. North Av to check for witnesses. They spoke with the manager, Kevin BARNETT, who stated he did not hear any shots and would be closing the bar for the night.

The caller stated his 15-year-old sister was in the bar and there were subjects smoking marijuana. The officers checked the ID's of the patrons and did not find anyone underage. No violations observed.

9. On 06/28/2019 officers were dispatched to T-Jay's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av, for a property damage complaint. The officer interviewed the victim who stated she was inside T-Jay's from 1:30am to 1:50am. When she came out her car door window was broken and items missing. The victim was found to be 20-years-old. The officer interviewed the manager and the door man who stated they did not let anyone underage in the bar. The applicant was issued a citation for Allow Underage on Premise.

- 10.On 07/01/2019 at 1:09am officers were dispatched to a subject with gun in the area of T-Jay's, 2911 W. North Av. The officer spoke with the caller by phone, who stated a security guard had brandished a firearm. The caller was uncooperative and hung up on the officer. The officer went to T-Jay's and spoke with the manager, Kevine BARNETT. He stated nothing out of the ordinary happened that night. The staff was very cooperative with the officers.
- 11. On 08/25/2019 at 2:20am officers were dispatched to N. 29<sup>th</sup> St and W. North Av for a shotspotter call of over 30 rounds fired. The officer interviewed the manager of T-Jay's, 2911 W. North Av. He stated they had no problems that night and were closing at 2:15am when they heard shots fired from a vehicle on the street. He provided video which showed a vehicle exit the parking lot to the west of T-Jay's and pull up to another vehicle on the street. One vehicle fired at another and both fled. One of the vehicles fleeing struck a parked car, flipping it on its side.
- 12.On 09/03/2019 at 1:08am officers were dispatched to T-Jay's lounge for a wanted subject. The subject was located and arrested without incident.
- 13. On 09/08/2019 at 1:17am officers conducted a licensed premise check at T-Jay's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av. The officer observed more than 80 cars in the area and conducted a capacity check. The door man stated he thought capacity was 136 and they had about 120-130 patrons. The officer checked and found capacity was 80 people. The bar was closed and all subjects were counted as they exited and the officer counted 213 people, which included employees. The investigation also revealed the bar was charging a cover charge, which wasn't posted and was serving food without a license. The manager stated they did not need a food dealer license because they were giving the food away. The applicant was cited for the violations.
- 14. On 09/22/2019 at 1:18am officers were dispatched to T-Jay's Lounge for a tavern violation. The caller stated there were several underage people inside the bar. The door man stated he knew the officers would be coming because he had turned away female with no ID. The officers checked the bar and did not locate anyone underage.
- 15. On 10/04/2019 a meeting was held at District 3 regarding T Jay's Lounge. The applicant stated she is not involved in the daily business, her husband Kevine BARNETT, runs the business. She stated she was unaware of several of the incidents at the business. She was advised of the recent incident on 09/08/2019 and the possible citations. She was advised to use a counter, post signs with prices and monitor patrons at close. She stated she would advise BARNETT of the information provided.

16. On 11/03/2019 at 1:55am officers were observing closing time at 2911 W. North Av. The officer observed a commotion out front which was blocking traffic. The officer cleared the crowd and spoke with a female, who stated she was trying to get back in the bar to get her friends shoes. She stated a security guard grabbed her by the head and pushed her out. The officer spoke with the bartender, who stated the subject described by the female was not an

employee. The officer attempted to locate the subject on several different dates but could not locate an employee matching the description.

17. On 11/23/2019 at 12:55am officers observed 65-70 cars parked outside of 2911 W. North Av. Knowing the capacity was 80 patrons the officer called for a supervisor and additional cars to conduct a capacity check. The officer spoke with the bartender, Kevin BARNETT, and asked him how many people were inside the tavern. The bartender stated 89 people and he knew it was over capacity. The bar was shut down and the patrons were counted as they exited. The officer counted a total of 118 people inside the bar. BARNETT stated he was counting patrons as they entered and showed the officer a handheld counter, which had 91 displayed. BARNETT stated his duties as the bartender pulled him away from the door so he may have missed patrons. BARNETT was advised to have a separate employee doing the count and to post the actual cover charge.

- 18. On 03/14/2020 at 2:00am officers conducted a license premise check at TJ's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av. The officers did not observe any loitering outside and observed staff keeping vehicles from stopping in front of the tavern. The officers observed closing and found it to be orderly.
- 19. On 08/02/2020 at 2:24am officers were dispatched to a Battery at N. 29<sup>th</sup> St and W. North Av. The officer observed a large group outside the business. They were directed to a female on the ground by a vehicle in the parking lot. The victim could not answer questions due to her intoxication level. The witnesses stated a male subject hit the victim with a 2x4 causing a cut to her head. The officers spoke with the manager, Kevin BARNETT, who stated the suspect has been banned because of this and other violations in the past. BARNETT stated cameras did not cover the incident. The officers questioned BARNETT about occupancy because of the large number of cars in the area. The officers reminded BARNETT that his capacity is 50% of normal because of the ongoing pandemic.

## INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Andrew KEMPEN, assigned to District 3, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, November 3rd St, Squad 3465, myself, and Squad 3430, P.O. Jesus MERCED and P.O. Lydia RIVERA-HOLEY, were monitoring the closing of 2911 W North Ave, T Jay's Lounge, when I observed a large commotion in the street directly in front of the front doors to the location which was causing traffic to back up. After clearing the crowd out I observed a female yelling at security. I approached the female who identified herself as Shaiindia S WHITTKER (F/B 6/20/96) who stated that she had been trying to get back into the bar because her girlfriend's shoes were still in side and the one security guard told her that she could but another one who she described as a black male caramel complexion, medium build, bald with a beard and wearing a red jacket told her that she couldn't come in and when she tried to tell him that the other guard told her she could to get the shoes he started to push her out and grabbed her by the head and pushed her out.

I spoke to Kevine BARNETT who was working as bartender and he told me that there was a large commotion at the door as they were watching their capacity and they were doing the push as it was closing time. BARNETT stated that he did not see any individual incident between any of his security and the patrons. I described the subject that the female had given me and he stated that he did not know who that female was talking about. BARNETT denied that anyone like that worked for him. I did not observe anyone in the bar the matched the description given.

I went back to WHITTKER who stated that she would like to press charges against the subject and I advised her that I would be conducting follow up to attempt to identify the security guard and get his side of the story and would be contacting her back once that was done. I checked the location the on 11/8/19 and 11/19/19 but did not locate the subject.

#### CAPACITY CHECK

Kempen, Andrew S 019729

11/23/2019

This report is written by P.O. Andrew KEMPEN assigned to District 3, Late Power Shift, Tavern Squad.

On November 23rd, 2019 at 12:55 PM, Squad 3465, P.O. Samuel KEHOSS and I, were driving past 2911 W North Ave when I observed a large number of cars around the bar and from my prior experiences with T Jay's Lounge this number of cars led me to believe they were over their capacity as their capacity is 80 and I observe approximately 65 to 70 cars in the area.

I contacted Squad 3412, Sgt William KINGSTON, and requested to conduct a capacity check of the location. Sgt KINGSTON requested additional squads to help with the check and Squad 3340, P.O. Herbert DAVIS and P.O. Adam GONZALEZ, Squad 3450, P.O. Taylor ZUBE and P.O. Jeremie GAINER, and Squad 3330, P.O. Andrew DUDLEY and Lauren MAROWSKY, responded to assist.

Squad 3330 monitored the rear of the location to make sure no one fled out the back. Squad 3450 shutdown traffic to allow for the safe exit of everyone in the bar. Squad 3340 went to the front door to assist with the crowd while Squad 3465 conducted the count and Squad 3412 oversaw everything.

Upon approaching the location I spoke to Kevine BARNETT, who is the licensed bartender at the location and I asked him how many people he had inside tonight and he advised that he had 89 and he knew that was over. I advised him that he was above that number and that he needed to shutdown the music and tell everyone to exit the bar. BARNETT cooperated and started everyone to the front door. I counted out every person leaving the bar out loud while my Axon Body Camera was activated and used a handheld counter to confirm my accuracy. After the majority of the patrons had exited the bar I entered and counted the remaining subjects inside for a total count of 118 which is 38 over their capacity.

I spoke to BARNETT outside of the location about the fact that he was again over capacity. BARNETT stated that he was the one counting everyone that was entering the location and he showed me that he had a handheld counter on him with a number of 91 on it. BARNETT stated that he tried to keep an accurate count but his duties in the bar had pulled him away from the bar from time to time. I advised him that it would be best for him to assign a worker to do the count and only to do the count so they have an accurate count and they don't run into this issue moving forward. I also advised BARNETT that he needs to have the actual amount of the cover charge posted and not just a sign that says cover charge. BARNETT stated that he would fix that immediately.

On 03/14/2020, at 2:00am, Squad 3465, P.O. ZUBE and I conducted a tavern check of TJ's Lounge located at 2911 W. North Ave.

During this time, we did observe a large amount of vehicle in the parking lot and parked on the street but not enough to believe that they were over capacity. We also did not observe any loitering outside of the tavern or in the parking lots. Tavern staff was outside keeping vehicles from stopping in front of the tavern blocking traffic. There was also a security vehicle in the parking lot with a visible light on top for additional security.

We did observe the tavern closing which began around 2:10am and did not observe any issues with disorderly patrons or traffic issues. Patrons left the area in orderly fasion.

#### INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Andrew KEMPEN, assigned to District 3, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, August 2nd, 2020 at 2:24 AM, Squad 3350, P.O. Tonya BRICE and P.O. Matthew SCHLAX, were dispatched to N 29th St and W North Ave for a battery complaint. I, Squad 3465, along with P.O. Taylor ZUBE responded to assist with the call.

Upon arriving on scene I observed a large crowd in the street outside of T Jay's Lounge, 2911 W North Ave. I was directed to a vehicle in the parking lot were a female subject, Shaquita S PERRY (F/B 3/7/93) was laying beside it with a minor laceration above her right eye brow. I was advised by several subjects around her that she was hit by a male subject known as "Pee Wee" who used a 2x4 to hit her in the head causing a small cut to her head. Squad 3350, P.O. Tonya BRICE and P.O. Matthew SCHLAX, took over that investigation and were unable to get a statement from PERRY due to her intoxication level.

I spoke to the manager of the location Kevine BARNETT who stated that the subject involved has been banned from the location even though he did not know the subjects name because he has caused problems at the location in the past and keeps being brought to the location by family. BARNETT stated that his cameras did not cover the incident.

I then spoke to BARNETT about the fact that we have noticed a larger number of vehicles in the area leading us to believe that he was going above capacity again. BARNETT stated that a number of the vehicles in the area are for a memorial for a fatal crash on 30th St just south of W North Ave. It should be noted that on our prior passes when he noticed the large number of vehicles we did not see anyone standing around the memorial. I also advised him that he was also suppose to be at only 50% his normal capacity.

He was advised that I would be filing a license premise report regarding.
