Regarding: Your Tattoo and Body Piercing Renewal Application for "Paris SC Crossley" at 3716 W Vliet St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

TESTIMONY FOR THE LICENSES COMMITTEE

July 17, 2017

I want to thank the Licenses Committee for the opportunity to provide my testimony as it relates to the Tattoo and Body Piercing Renewal Application.

I am a resident of West Vliet Street which is next to the tattoo shop. owns the two buildings of the tattoo shop. I am a proponent of good businesses in my neighborhood because it stimulates the value of properties and the neighborhood. However, if its business negatively affects the peaceful enjoyment of my home and neighborhood then I would rather not have it. Since the tattoo shop opens for business these were the problems that it created for me, my family, and neighborhood:

- 1) Attracted suspicious individuals into the neighborhood – there was pungent odor of either marijuana or some kind of drug in front of the shop and my home every day; I cannot open my window for fresh air without having the smell wafting into my home. There were people who greeted each other and it appeared that there was some sort of exchange going on. Lewd remarks and behavior were directed towards my children and their friends from church when they walk by.
- 2) Loitering and loud music everyday even after 10 p.m. – the shop had customers late into the night
- 3) Customers parking in my private parking lot although several No-Parking signs are posted all over the parking lot. When politely asked to move their cars, they threatened and challenged me. I've tried calling parking enforcement but by the time they come, the customer's gone. The few times I called, it took between 45 minutes to more than one hour for the officer to stop by.
- 4) Men urinating in the back of the parking lot, even in broad daylight.
- 5) Littering – people leaving their trash on the front steps of both buildings. Cigarette butts are scattered on the sidewalk in the front of the buildings.

These problems were completely gone after the business closed down due to the fire in January.

Mr. Crossley may continue his tattoo business if he resolve or can present a viable plan to address these problems; otherwise I ask that the Committee disapprove of the renewal of his license. I do not object to any business that would bring value to this neighborhood. So far, Mr. Crossley's business has not.

I hope that you will take my testimony into consideration because I believe that you would not tolerate such activities in your business neighborhood. Again, thank you for your time and the opportunity.

Dear Whomever It May Concern;

I could not attend the hearing scheduled for today, May 31 at 9:30am because of employment schedule issue. However, I strongly oppose the renewal of Mr. Crossley's application to continue the tattoo and body piercing business to my home,
The reasons are:

1. Since the opening of the tattoo and body piercing store, I've been having problems with his customers trespassing my private parking lot. I have no-parking signs in several visible locations. I've called City parking enforcement office several times to have these people ticketed and towed but by the time the officer arrive, which is any where between 30 minutes to one hour, the people already left. They either block the entrance to my private parking lot or park in it as if they own the property. I've spoken to the customers asking the customers to move their vehicle and pointing to the signs, they've threaten, ignore, and treated me with indifference.
2. This business brings people who have no respect for people, property, or rules. They throw trash all over the place. Some customers smoke marijuana and loiter in front of the store and my home until as late as 11pm with loud music and talking, especially during summer and fall months. They make inappropriate remarks and gestures towards my girls. We are afraid to go outside because of these types of people.

Please consider my written testimony and do not renew the license application for Mr. Crossley's tattoo and body piercing business.

13. On 09/30/15 at 3:32 pm, Milwaukee police investigated a complaint of possible synthetic marijuana being sold at Hustlin Hands Tobacco and Accessories at 3714 W Vliet Street. Undercover police officers entered the establishment and requested to purchase single cigarettes from an employee that was behind a partially enclosed counter. The undercover officer purchased two Newport brand cigarettes, which were fifty cents apiece. Another UC entered and approached the same store employee and requested to purchase synthetic marijuana. The employee advised the UC that it would be \$15.00 for his request. The UC purchased a package with the brand name "Wolfpack" on the front. Uniformed officers, as well as agents from the Department of Revenue, entered the business and conducted a license premise check. The store employee, identified as Rico Townsend, was very agitated and uncooperative, refusing to answer questions. Investigation found that Townsend was found to be in possession of suspected marijuana. Officers also recovered evidence of the earlier buys, as well as two spiral notebooks with information noted on the daily transactions of the business which also included documentation of the purchase of K2 for \$15.00 and single cigarettes for \$1.00 by the UC officers. Agents confiscated a box that contained several packages of "Wolfpack" that was found on a table behind the counter. An officer contacted the licensee, Paris S Crossley and advised him of the situation at his establishment with Crossley stating he was on his way to the business. Crossley never showed up. Agents KING and UHLIG confiscated all cigarette and tobacco products as there were no invoices on the premises. The clerk, Rico TOWNSEND, was cited for Unlawful Sale of Cigarettes and currently has a warrant for said citation. (15058516)

14. On 01/22/17 at 6:46 pm, Milwaukee police responded to 3716 W Vliet Street for robbery/attempt kidnapping complaint. Police spoke with an employee, identified as Kenny Winters, who stated he was tattooing a subject when 3 masked males entered the business all armed with guns. Winters stated that one of the subjects stated to him something similar to, "Hey Kenny, let's talk outside". Winters stated he was frightened and did not know what the subjects wanted, so he and another guy who was in the business ran to the rear of the store and out the back door. Winters stated the subjects ran out the front door. During the investigation, police found a back room that connects two buildings (3714 and 3716) which is shared by Hustlin Handz Signs and H & H Tattoo. Police observed in plain view, a clear plastic bag containing a green leafy substance, suspected of marijuana. Also observed were 3 glass pipes with marijuana residue inside. The tattoo shop had a strong odor of burnt

marijuana. The suspected substance later tested positive for THC and placed on police inventory. Police attempted to contact the owner, Paris Crossley by telephone, but were unsuccessful.

This report is written by P.O. Jason DEWITT assigned to District 3, early shift. On Sunday, 01/22/17 at 6:46 p.m., squad 3281 (DEL MORAL and DEWITT), squad 3284 (BRAUNREITER and SWEENEY), and 3273 (DAVIS and GALLENBERG) responded to H & H (Hustlin Handz) Tattoo located at 3716 W. Vliet St. An employee of the tattoo shop, Kenny WINTERS (m/b, 01-23-92), (#414-501-9852) called 911 and reported a group of males had entered the tattoo shop with firearms and were attempting to rob and/or kidnap him.

Upon our arrival, we located the caller/employee WINTERS, his relative, Lure WEBB (m/b, 01-17-96) coming from the rear of the business located at 3716 W. Vliet St. H&H tattoo is connected to Hustlin Handz Signs (3714 W. Vliet St.) by a rear room. Upon checking Hustlin Handz Signs, an employee Edward PACKER (m/b, 11-25-93) #414-690-1487) and two customers, Justice KING (m/b, 07-02-1999) and Octavius BOLTON (m/b, 10-28-92) were located in a bathroom. Also located in bathroom were two handguns.

In the back room, connecting 3714 and 3716 W. Vliet St., in plain view, a clear plastic bag, containing a green leafy substance, suspected marijuana was located. Also observed were three (3) glass pipes with marijuana residue inside. The tattoo shop and rear room had a strong odor of burnt marijuana. P.O. DEL MORAL tested the green leafy substance, which tested positive for THC, marijuana, 0.36 grams. The marijuana was placed on MPD inventory #17002632. The glass pipes were placed on MPD inventory #17002629.

I spoke with the caller, WINTERS who stated he was tattooing KING when three (3) black males walked in the business. WINTERS stated all three (3) were wearing black full face ski masks. WINTERS stated all three (3) were wearing all black clothing. WINTERS stated one subject was armed with a silver/black semi automatic pistol. WINTERS stated the second subject was armed with a semi-automatic rifle. WINTERS stated the first male stated to him something similar to "Hey Kenny, let's talk outside". WINTERS stated he was frightened and did not know what the subjects wanted, so he and WEBB ran to the rear of the business and out the back door. WINTERS stated the subjects ran out the front door.

During the investigation, I checked the posted licenses for both 3714 and 3716 W. Vliet St. The following is the information I gathered from the licenses on the premises;

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



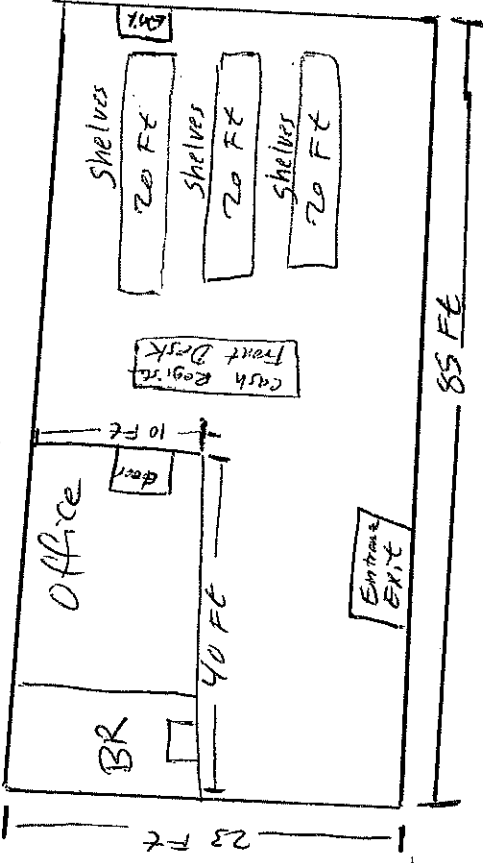
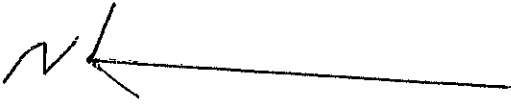

PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Ryan SHARP, assigned to the Third District, Day Shift.

On Tuesday, May 2, 2017, at approximately 1:18 pm, P.O. Gregory BYERS and I, assigned to Squad 3190 (wearing full duty uniform and operating a marked MPD squad) were patrolling the area of N. 30th St. and W. Brown St. P.O. BYERS observed a black hose running from the front door of 30th St. Liquor (2001 N. 30th St.) and into the city storm drain.

P.O. BYERS and I placed ourselves on a business check and entered the location. Inside I spoke with employee Kevin R. HOXWORTH (w/m 06/07/77). HOXWORTH stated the hose was connected to a sump pump and pulling water out of the basement. I informed HOXWORTH it was against city code to do that, and that he would have to turn the pump off.

An investigation revealed that the sump pump was pumping raw sewage into the city storm drain, as the lateral from the main sewer to the business was clogged.

HOXWORTH was then asked to produce his Class D operator's license for the sale of alcohol. HOXWORTH explained he did not have one, and was unaware that one was required.

HOXWORTH stated he had been an employee for approximately 3 months and did not realize that an individual with a Class D operator's license had to be with him for him to conduct sales. HOXWORTH stated it was common for his manager to leave him unattended on a regular basis. I requested that HOXWORTH contact his manager and have him come to the store to discuss the discrepancies.

HOXWORTH contacted Inderjeet DHILLON (a/m 01/24/59) and requested he come to the store. While awaiting DHILLON's arrival, I observed that some of the milk, meat, and eggs were past their expiration periods.

Calls were placed to the Department of Neighborhood Services and the Department of Health.

When DHILLON arrived, I informed him of the issues and what corrections would have to be made. DHILLON stated that he was working on getting HOXWORTH his Class D operator's license, and that he was normally at the store with HOXWORTH. DHILLON stated he had not been there as there was a death in the family earlier in the week.

D.N.S. employee John YANG informed DHILLON the sump pump would have to be fixed by Friday, May 5, 2017, and that D.N.S. would be checking on the store on that date to ensure compliance.

D.O.H. employee Rob KIESER cited the business for having a carton of milk that was bulging due to its' age and bacterial growth. Additionally the business had eggs that were past their expiration period and packaged meat that had become discolored from being in the refrigeration unit for too long a period of time. D.O.H. employee KIESER had HOXWORTH dispose of the meat and eggs in the garbage and required that HOXWORTH pour the milk out in the utility sink at the back of the business.

I spoke with DHILLON who informed me that Thomas J. HOLMES II (b/m 05/18/84) was the Class A license holder, and that he maintained a Class D, operator's license. I informed DHILLON that he had to remain at the store in order for HOXWORTH to sell alcohol. DHILLON stated he understood, and would work on getting HOXWORTH his Class D, operator's license.

HOLMES was cited for having an employee of his business operating without a Class D operator's license.

HOXWORTH was issued a verbal warning for not having his Class D operator's license.

Community Service Officer Alina CHA (Squad 3193) took 11 photos at approximately 2:42 pm, depicting the business and violations.

As both victims and the subject fled, both suspects shot at them.

Victim #1 sustained a gunshot wound to his right buttocks. Victim #2 sustained a gunshot wound to his right buttocks. Suspect #1 also obtained \$230 from Victim #2's pants pocket.

While the suspects were shooting, multiple shots were fired into the business at 2001 N. 30th St, Best Liquor. A Best Liquor clerk, Inderjit KAUR, was inside the store at the time the shots were fired. The suspects caused damage the business property by shattering the glass to the front door.

Both the clerk and store manager were cooperative in providing video surveillance footage of the incident. The store is equipped with interior cameras only.



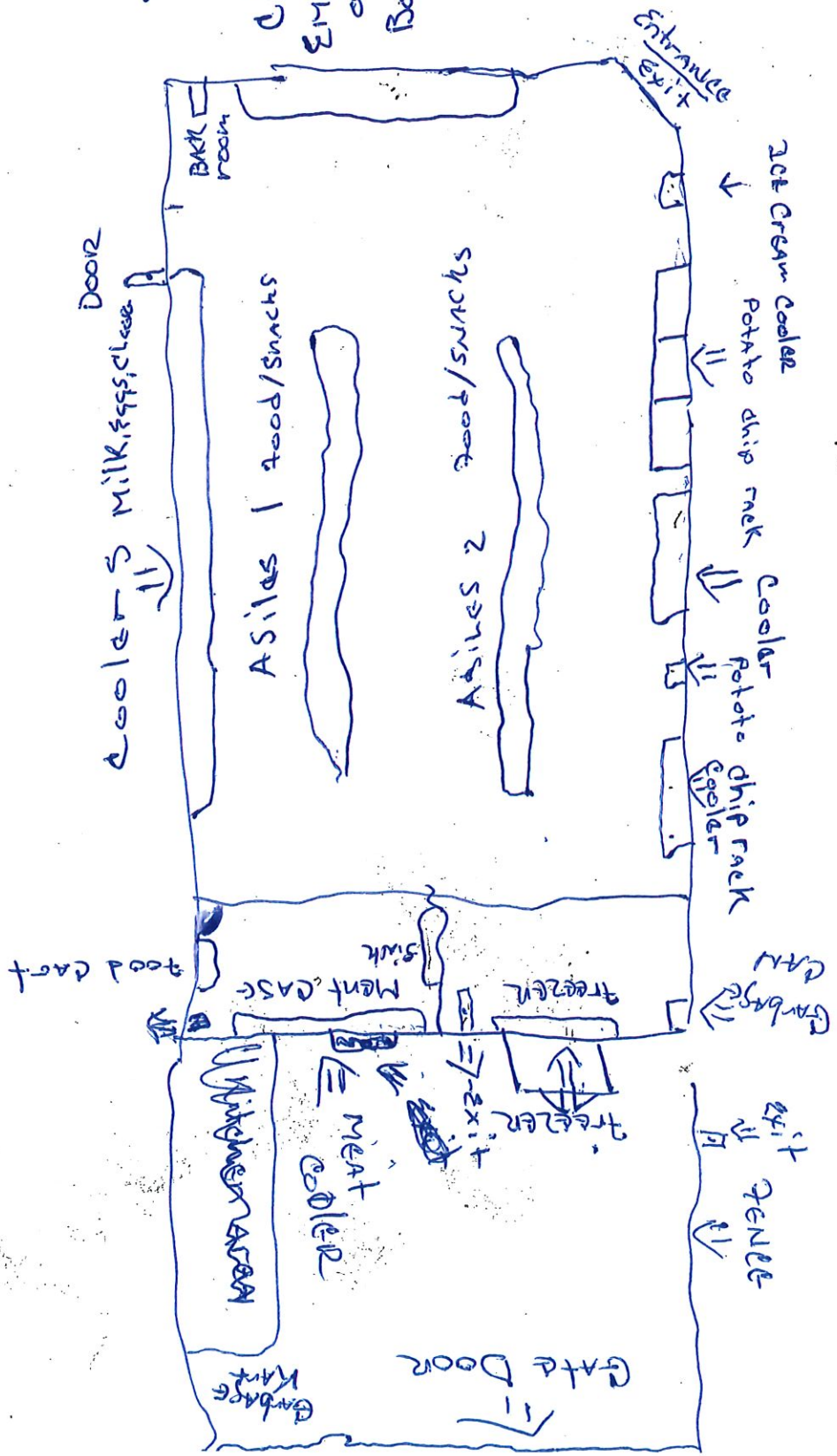
