There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.



After testifying at the license renewal hearing last year, I spoke with the current manager and the lawyer representing Little Caesar's. They assured me that they would reach out to me and connect me with a representative in their corporate office. After several months without a response, I contacted the lawyer directly and he eventually connected me with Rob Berro, who I have been in communication with since.

In our conversations since, we have discussed each of the concerns listed above. I'm concerned that only minimal, if any, action has been taken to remedy these issues despite repeated promises including new fencing, signage to discourage loud music in the parking lot, better shoveling, trash/litter removal, etc.

They did respond to my concerns over a leaking gutter that was dumping significant amounts of water onto my property. They also cleared sidewalks after I brought it to their attention that there was 15"+ after two weeks of snowfall this winter.

The last communication suggested that a new bid for fencing was received and that it was moving forward, though it was "still waiting for final approval" from management.

My most recent concern involves pests and trash. I've removed 5 dead rats from the area behind my garage this spring. I obviously can't be sure they're coming from Little Caesars; but there is at least one dead behind their building in a space with a bunch of trash/debris. I've also seen poison/traps near their dumpster, indicating there is a problem there.

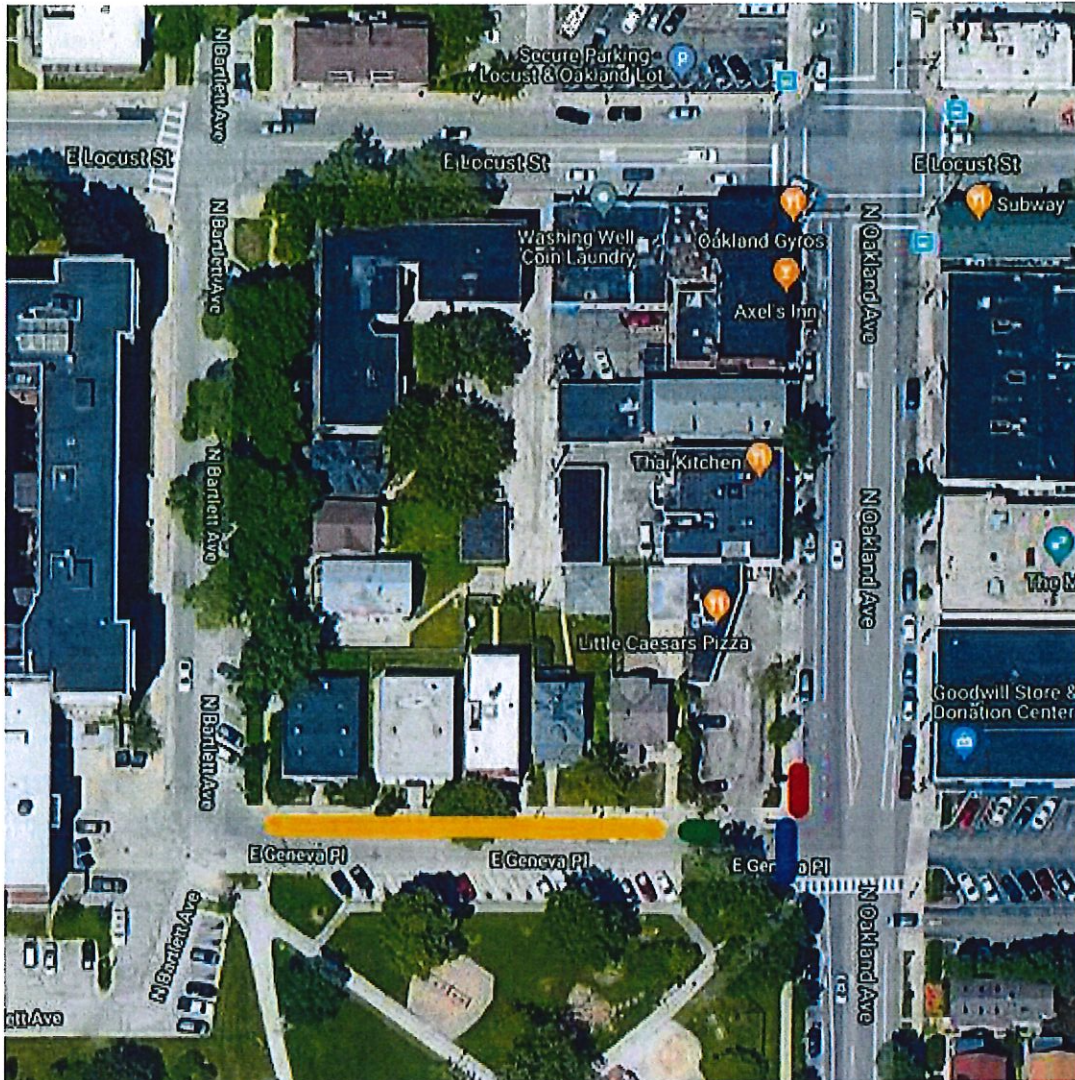
Hi Nik,

I have a couple questions about some things happening in my neighborhood. Feel free to give me a call at if that is easier.

- Has a date been set for Little Caesar's license review? I think it was in June last year and I want to try and mobilize a few other residents. While I've been in contact with someone over the last year and they've perhaps made some minor improvements in the shoveling/trash, they've done nothing regarding the fence line, parking, loud music, etc. So I'm inclined to think they're just stalling. Also, I just saw the city came out with some new landscaping requirements for parking lots. Is this only for new projects, or is this standard enforceable for existing spots?

- Is there a process for petitioning a change to parking? I've NEVER seen a parking enforcement on my street, which only makes the following more problematic. (See picture for reference to questions #1-4)

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1) 2-hr street parking on the N side of Geneva Pl (Orange). This seems redundant given the fact that there is 2-hr angle parking on the other side of the street. It also creates problems for the dozens of buses that use the street every morning and afternoon. Further, it can take 20-25 minutes to get from Locust to Oakland during school dismissal, which frustrates drivers and results in some pretty terrible driving, making it dangerous for the students who are darting in and out of traffic. Could we consider no parking on the N side of the street, or at least no parking on school days? This would allow for more room to separate into left and right turn lanes and speed up the process.

2) Parking between driveways (Green). This is still an issue. People block my driveway all the time. Only part of the curb is painted yellow, but there is a sign. Can the rest of the curb be painted?

4) Crosswalk on Geneva (Blue). Is it possible to get this painted, along with a stop bar for cars?

Additionally, I don't know if there is anything else that can be done, but we still get a LOT of cars going the wrong way on our street. and I have both had a number of close calls where we nearly collided right where the street turns. People come flying around that corner in the wrong direction all the time. Perhaps there can be a "DO NOT ENTER" painted on the ground?

I'm happy to do some petitioning if signatures are needed for changes. Let me know if we have any options for the above.

Little Caesar's License Hearing - June 2018

My name is _____ and I live at _____ with my partner _____. Our home is directly _____ to the Little Caesars Pizza, located at 2831 N. Oakland Ave. I am opposed to the renewal of the applicant's food dealer license, as I believe continued operation of their business represents a threat to residents' safety and peaceful enjoyment of the neighborhood.

Living _____ to the business, I'm confronted daily with illegal, irresponsible, and inconsiderate activity that originates in or around the store. This includes:

- regular drug use
- excessive loud/profane music
- frequent verbal altercation
- wreckless & illegal parking/driving (see photos - blocking driveway, wrong-way)
- pervasive litter/trash (see photos)
- dangerous snowy/icy sidewalks (plowed, not shoveled)
- late night nuisance (hood cleaning, Tuesday delivery)

On August 13, 2017, shots were fired in front of our home following an altercation involving employees and patrons in the parking lot. I called the police waited as the shooter walked back into the parking lot and continued his conversation with employees. When they heard the approaching sirens, the shooter left the scene in his vehicle (I recorded the license plate and vehicle description) and the employees wished him good luck.

I think it is reasonable to expect a certain amount of nuisance behavior living in a dense, mixed-use neighborhood with a high student population and a park/playground across the street. I also think it is reasonable to expect a business to answer for the behavior of its patrons and employees when such behavior is negatively impacts the lives of its neighbors.

In the last year, I've called the police when witnessing illegal activity, confronted patrons directly about being courteous and respectful, reported neighborhood issues through the city website, and spoken with my alderman.

I also reached out to a representative from corporate management (Isaiah Underwood) about some concerns. He agreed to: make staff changes as if warranted or provide supplemental training, put up signs to encourage patrons to be courteous to neighbors, and consider a more solid fence. I agreed to solicit bids for new fencing/wall and remove the damaged tree on the property line. I don't believe any of those changes have been made. Recently, the store was

closed for several days to make improvements to the store, however none of this investment was focused on creating a safer, cleaner, environment for the neighborhood.

To whom it may concern:

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/4/2019 at 10:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.



The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 11/30/18 at 12:25am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check for underage patrons at 1832 E. North Avenue (Vitucci's). The tavern passed the compliance check.
2. On 12/15/19 at 2:30am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a battery complaint. Officers interviewed the caller who stated that the staff at the tavern threw his drink on the ground and threw him to the ground multiple times. Officers interviewed an employee (Angelo M VITUCCI) who stated that the caller was disturbing two females at the bar and was asked multiple times to leave the females alone. When the caller refused, the bartender asked the caller to leave and took his drink. The caller grabbed another patrons' cocktail and a napkin holder and threw it at the bartender. The caller was then escorted outside the tavern. The caller attempted to gain access back into the bar and was pushed by VITUCCI. The video shows the caller stumble backwards to the ground but doesn't show who pushed him. There was video surveillance of the incident and it inventoried.
3. On 01/17/19, Milwaukee Police conducted a capacity check at 1832 E. North Avenue. Investigation revealed that the tavern was 57 patrons over capacity. The establishment's capacity is 160. When Police entered the establishment, they were met by the acting manager, Angelo M VITUCCI who stated that he had an employee meeting before the tavern was open and told his staff to keep count of patrons, so he thought they were below capacity for the evening. While interviewing the acting manager, officers observed an intoxicated subject inside the tavern after hours wearing a pink wrist band which indicated that he was a patron.

VITUCCI said that he was an employee but had "clocked out" at 10:30 and did not know he was not supposed to be in the establishment. The patron was cited and acting manager, VITUCCI, was told the agent would be receiving a citation.

4. On 01/22/19 at 8:19pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a battery complaint. Video Surveillance revealed that two patrons (KRIMMER and BUGGY) were involved in a physical altercation inside the establishment and an off duty employee (MUNS) broke up the skirmish. During the fight, officers observed, on video, what appeared to be a firearm in KRIMMERS' back waistband. Shortly after the fight was stopped by MUNS, and before police arrive, video shows MUNS, KRIMMER, and another employee quickly get up from the bar and walk out of camera view, returning a short time later. KRIMMER and MUNS were asked about the firearm and they said they did not see one. The manager, Angelo VITUCCI, showed KRIMMER the surveillance footage before police arrival and told officers that he has a "no firearm" policy inside his establishment. The manager, VITUCCI, believed KRIMMER had a firearm during the altercation. Buggy consented to a PBT which resulted in a .34 reading. KRIMMER and BUGGY were mailed Disorderly Conduct citations.
5. On 02/07/19 at 4:00pm, a meeting was held at the First District Police Station in regards to item #3. Present at the meeting was Officer MICHALAK, Sergeant GAUERKE, Assistant District Attorney, Assistant City Attorney, Agent Julie VITUCCI, Angelo VITUCCI, and an attorney for the agent. Angelo stated he took extra security measures that night to make sure that they did not go over capacity. VITUCCI's lawyer stated he had video proof they were not over capacity and would present that to the City Attorney. Both Julie and Angelo were professional and courteous during the meeting.
6. On 03/28/19 at 11:41pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a noise complaint. Officers interviewed the manager, Angelo VITUCCI, who was outside the establishment and stated he did not have any exterior speakers that were playing music, but the front entrance door was propped open. He was informed per City Ordinances the doors to the tavern must remain closed after 10pm and exterior music must be turned off on the weekdays at 10pm. Angelo said that he was not aware of these "rules" and would close the door. Angelo was informed by officers that this was not the first call for this type of complaint and if it continues, he would receive a citation.
7. On 04/04/19 at 11:01pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1832 E. North Avenue for a noise complaint. Upon arrival, officers could hear the music coming from the patio speakers from approximately a half block away. The manager, Angelo VITUCCI, was asked to turn the music off and he complied. Angelo, in the recent past, was warned multiple times about having music playing after 10pm and was told by officers that the agent would be issued a citation for tonight's violation. At 12:07am, Milwaukee Police received another complaint of loud music coming from the patio at 1832 E. North Avenue. Milwaukee Police returned to the scene and found that the music was, again, playing from the patio speakers. Again, Angelo was told to turn off the patio speaker and, again, he complied.

8. On 04/19/19, Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up on a complaint that an underage employee consumed alcohol at the tavern located at 1832 E. North Avenue. Officers confirmed that the underage employee was admitted to St. Mary's Hospital with the blood alcohol level of .394. Officers went to 1832 E. North Avenue (Vitucci's) and interviewed the manager Angelo M. VITUCCI. Angelo showed officers surveillance video which showed that at 1:47am, the underage employee was sitting at the bar with a drink in her hand and the bartender poured her a shot of alcohol (which she then drank). The bartender, who poured the underage employee a shot, said that the underage employee could not walk to her friend's car, so he picked her up and carried her to the car. The bartender thought that the friend who picked up the underage employee was her roommate.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/05/2014 a Milwaukee police officer observed two subjects fighting outside 1832 East North Avenue (Vitucci's). Investigation revealed one of the combatants is working as security at the business; the other was a patron of the business who became upset when he was thrown out of the tavern. Both combatants were cited for, and eventually convicted of, Disorderly Conduct.

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2. On 05/03/2014 a 19 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to Vitucci's (1832 East North Avenue) but was turned away at the door when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.

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3. On 02/20/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 1832 East North Avenue (Vitucci's Tavern) and provided the manager, Candice Kopca, with a packet of tavern related ordinances.
4. On 02/27/2015 an 18 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to 1832 East North Avenue (Vitucci's Tavern) but was turned away when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
5. On 03/19/2015 Vitucci's (1832 East North Avenue) requested that officers give instruction on how to identify a fake identification card. Officers also took questions from staff members on professional communications and dealing with un-cooperative patrons.
6. On 05/14/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to 2463 North Oakland Avenue regarding a call for police. A female told officers she had been sexually assaulted while at Vitucci's Bar (1832 East North Avenue). During the investigation, officers discovered the victim was 19 years old. No citations were issued and Milwaukee police incident report #151340013 was filed.
7. On 12/03/2015 a Milwaukee police officer observed, on three separate occasions, subjects jump the railing at Vitucci's cocktail lounge (1832 East North Avenue).
8. On 03/21/2016 Milwaukee police conducted fake identification training class at 2022 East North Avenue. Representatives from the tavern were shown how to detect fake identification.

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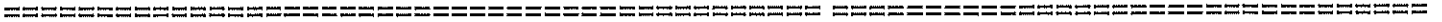
9. On 07/01/2016 an officer delivered a Respect 21 failure letter to Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av. The letter was left with an employee because the applicant was not on scene. A citation for the original offense date of 12/04/2015 was issued.

10. On 09/16/2016 at 1:30am officers spoke to security at Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av, regarding noise complaints at closing. The officers recommended that security staff clear the sidewalks immediately upon closing to help avoid any issues.
11. On 09/16/2016 at 1:33am officers observed an extremely intoxicated subject being helped out of Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av. The subject was conveyed to the hospital in protective custody for being Incapacitated by Alcohol. The officers determined the subject was under age and had used a real WI ID that was not hers. The bar was not issued citations.

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12. On 03/30/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av. The Police Aid was denied entry at the door.



13. On 04/17/2018 officers investigated a one car accident at Oakland and Kenwood. The investigation revealed the driver, who in 19 years of age, had been drinking with friends at Vitucci's. When asked how she got in to Vitucci's without an ID she stated she was with a group of friends but did not purchase any drinks.

14. On 04/18/2018 officers went to Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av, to conduct a license premise check, checking for underage patrons. Upon arrival the officers observed a young looking female at the rear of the location. The subject was found to be 19 years old and stated she entered the bar at 9:30pm and no one was at the door checking ID's. The officers spoke with the manager, Angelo VITUCCI. She stated he would check the cameras to see how the female got in. On 04/19/2018 the officers followed up with Angelo VITUCCI, who stated the female did come in when no one was at the door. She sat at a table with other patrons who made the alcohol purchases, the female never approached the bar. The female was cited for being on the premise and the bar was cited for Allowing underage Patron on Premise.

15. On 06/22/2018 officers were dispatched to a fight at 1832 E. North Av. The investigation revealed the incident was a Battery DV that occurred inside Vitucci's. The manager, Angelo VITUCCI, was cooperative with the investigation.

16. On 07/05/2018 officers were dispatched to a shooting at Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av. The investigation revealed the incident occurred in the outside patio area that can only be accessed through the bar. The victim was involved in a fight with two other patrons when one produced what appeared to be a fire arm. The manager, Angelo VITUCCI, was on scene and cooperative. The bartender, Cody CRANGLE, stated they did not use the ID scanner this day because it was a Wednesday and they did not have anyone at the door to perform this task.

17. On 09/20/2018 officers went to Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av, for a licensed premise check. Upon arrival the officer observed the patio area to be standing room only and the interior bar extremely crowded. The officer asked the security guard at the door what his count of patrons inside was and he stated 158. The officer spoke with the manager, Angelo VITUCCI, who stated the bars capacity was 160. The officers conducted a count of patrons and found the bar to be 155 patrons over capacity. Angelo was advised the agent would receive a citation for over capacity.

18. On 09/28/2018 officers were dispatched to a sick and injured call at 1832 E. North Av. While conducting the investigation the officer observed the tavern appeared to be over this listed capacity of 160. She asked the employee at the front door what his count was and he stated 168. The manager, Angelo VITUCCI, took over the front door count and agreed they were over capacity. A Sergeant responded and a count of patrons entering and leaving was conducted. After closing it was determined the bar was 43 people over capacity.

19. On 10/02/2018 at 2:40am officers observed several people inside Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av, after closing time. As the officers approached they observed Angelo VITUCCI exit the front door and reenter locking the door behind him. The officers knocked on the door and it was opened by VITUCCI. The occupants stated VITUCCI was in charge. The officer observed that VITUCCI appeared to be intoxicated. They also observed people walking around the back of the tavern. The officers located people hiding in the freezer drinking beer. After locating these patrons VITUCCI told officers they had to leave and that his attorney told him to leave if the officer would not. VITUCCI then attempted to leave and the officer detained him outside. VITUCCI told someone to close and lock the door, locking the officer's partner inside the business. Additional cars responded and the officer inside opened the door. While walking out the door VITUCCI kicked the door closed striking the officer. VITUCCI was arrested for Resisting or Obstructing an Officer. The officers located 11 people who were not employees in the business.
20. On 10/04/2018 a meeting was held at District one regarding Vitucci's. Present from the business was Angelo VITUCCI and Julie VITUCCI. Angelo was asked what his duties were and he stated he was in charge of day to day operations. The officers determined Angelo could not receive the citations for recent incidents, so on 10/11/2018 they responded to the agent's residence to issue her three citations (2 citations for Over capacity, and 1 citation for Patrons After Hours). At this time she advised them that in June 2018 she submitted a letter to City Hall requesting to be removed as agent.
21. On 10/15/2018 officers responded to Vitucci's, 1832 E. North Av, after receiving information that the agent, Angela VITUCCI-BONFIGLIO, had turned in the license. The officer spoke with Angelo VITUCCI, who stated he thought they had 10 days to hire a new agent and they were in the process. The paperwork has not yet been filed with the city. The officers advised the business need to be closed until the paperwork for the new agent is filed. VITUCCI was cooperative and did close the bar.

This report is written by P.O. Richard MICHALAK, assigned to District One, Late Power shift. On Thursday, January 17th, 2019 while assigned to squad #1420 with P.O. NORTHWOOD, we responded to 1832 E. North Av to conduct a tavern check at approximately 11:53 P.M.

In my personal experience Vitucci's is usually busy on Thursday nights for their drink special but appeared to be more busy than usual based on a long line to enter the bar, I observed earlier in the evening. P.O. NORTHWOOD was parked on E North Ave facing westbound observing the main entrance keeping count on patrons exiting and entering the establishment. I observed the patio on the East side of the building to see if anyone exited the establishment or entered.

It should be noted that P.O. NORTHWOOD started the count of the patrons leaving at 11:53 P.M. P.O NORTHWOOD and I kept the count until the bar was closed and empty for the evening. Sgt. Thomas ACKLEY was informed of our observations and the amount of patrons exiting and entering the establishment. P.O. NORTHWOOD'S count was at 192 at 2:00 A.M., and shortly after observed five more of what appeared to be patrons exiting the establishment. I observed nine patrons exit the east door during my count prior to 2:00 a.m. While we were in the establishment I counted eleven employees inside cleaning. Their capacity is 160, P.O. NORTHWOOD and my count was total of 217 including employees. Vitucci's was over by 57 patrons.

We entered the bar at approximately 2:06 A.M., and were greeted by the acting manager Angelo M. VITUCCI (W/M 10/9/1996). Angelo stated that he had a staff meeting before the bar was open and stressed to his employee's to make sure they keep count of patron's entering and exiting the establishment. Angelo was informed that a license check of his current B License showed that he has a capacity of 160. Angelo stated he was aware of that and believed to be at or below capacity.

It should be noted that Sgt. ACKLEY and I observed Markey J. WALKER (b/m, 10-12-91) was in the establishment at (2:10 A.M.) after hours, intoxicated, and wearing a pink wrist band like those issued to other bar patrons this evening. WALKER was working but had clocked out at 10:30 P.M. according to Angelo. We asked Angelo why WALKER was still in the establishment if he was not working, ANGELO stated "I thought he could still be in there even after he clocked out". WALKER was malled a citation for being in the establishment after hours. (cit# M5816WD6N1)

Sgt. ACKLEY, Sgt. GAUERKE, P.O. NORTHWOOD, and I met with Angelo after the bar was closed and informed him that the agent of the establishment would be receiving this citation and a tavern report would be done.

On Tuesday, January 22nd 2019, at approximately 8:19PM, I was dispatched to Vitucci's Bar located at 1832 E. North Av. for a battery complaint. Upon arrival Christopher C. BUGGY (W/M 07-30-85) was standing outside speaking with PO Jacob WASECHECK and PO Paul HELMINIAK (squad 1231) was inside with David L. KRIMMER (W/M 05-29-79). BUGGY stated that he was beat up by his friend KRIMMER. BUGGY'S speech was slurred, his eyes were bloodshot and glassy.

Upon review of the surveillance camera I observed Buggy slap KRIMMER in the face. KRIMMER grabbed BUGGY and they both fell to the ground. I observed KRIMMER punching BUGGY while he was on the ground. During the altercation I observed what appeared to be a firearm located in the back waistband of KRIMMER'S pants. One of the Vitucci's bouncers, Dylan S. MUNS (B/M 01-14-94) who stated he was not working, only drinking broke up the fight. MUNS was standing over the two fighting and stated he did not see any firearm.

Shortly after the fight stopped, Angelo VITUCCI, The Manager of Vitucci's showed KRIMMER the footage of the physical altercation. KRIMMER went back into the bar area, where BUGGY was still standing by the entrance. KRIMMER pushed BUGGY to the ground one more time. BUGGY left Vitucci's then called Police. BUGGY stated he did not want anything to be done, he just wanted to KRIMMER to apologize.

On video, just before PO WASECHECK AND HELMINIAK walked in the bar, KRIMMER, MUNS, and another employee quickly got up from the bar, walked out of camera view and returned shortly. When asked about the firearm, KRIMMER and MUNS stated there was no gun.

I asked Angelo VITUCCI if he had a firearm policy, and he stated has a No Firearms sign posted at the entrance. VITUCCI believed KRIMMER to have a firearm as well.

The video was placed on MPD inventory #19002725.

BUGGY consented to a PBT which resulted in a .34. BUGGY called for an Uber and left. KRIMMER left Vitucci's before we were able to issue a PBT to him.

BUGGY and KRIMMER were both mailed Disorderly Conduct citations.

On Friday, April 19, 2019 while assigned to squad #1442 with PO Eric NORTHWOOD, we were asked to conduct follow up at Vitucci's cocktail lounge regarding an employee who is under the age of 21 and was at the bar drinking.

We received an anonymous tip that ENDRIES, Evangeline J. (W/F 10/14/1999) is a bartender at Vitucci's. The tip informed us that Evangeline was at Vitucci's on 4/12/19 when she was not scheduled to work and was drinking with other employees. We were informed that Evangeline was so intoxicated that she had to be taken to St. Mary's Hospital because she could not take care of her self.

We changed locations to St. Mary's Hospital and spoke with the registration nurse who informed us that Evangeline was admitted at 4:19 AM on 4/12/19. The nurse stated that Evangeline was brought in by private auto and had a blood alcohol level of .394.

We then changed locations to Vitucci's and spoke with the manager VITUCCI, Angelo M. (W/M 10/9/1996) who showed us video from inside of the tavern on 4/12/19. Angelo identified Evangeline sitting at the front bar at 1:47 AM, we observed her with a drink in her hand and the bartender pour her a shot that she did drink. It appeared that Evangeline was walking around the bar, however we were unable to figure out what time she entered the bar. It should also be noted that the surveillance camera jumps from 2:16 AM- 2:24 AM, 2:32 AM - 3:14 AM, and 3:27 AM - 3:45 AM so we were unable to see the exact time that Evangeline left the bar. Angelo stated the cameras work off of a motion detector and sometimes the cameras jump like that.

We identified the bartender as PERINE, Sylwen A. (B/M 2/10/1993) who stated Evangeline could not walk to her friends car so he picked her up and carried her to the car. Sylwen stated that he thought the friend that picked up Evangeline was her roommate.

We informed Angelo that this License Premise report would be filed.
