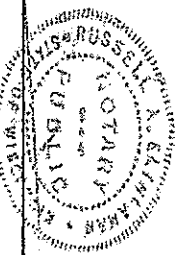

Substitute resolution approving levying of assessments and construction of assessable public improvement projects at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City cost of these projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$346,400 for a total estimated cost of \$581,500.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions, determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct and levy special assessments for the following improvements:

4th Aldermanic District
N. Jefferson St. - E. Krapp St. to E. Ogden Ave. and E. Knapp St. - N. Jefferson St. to N. Milwaukee St. (ST211150208): Install traffic calming speed hump(s). (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$5,200; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$7,100). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$13,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2015-2016 construction season.

Alley between W. Highland Blvd., W. Juneau Ave., N. 25th St. and N. 33rd St. (ST211150206): Install traffic calming speed hump(s). (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$12,000; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$1,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$13,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2015-2016 construction season.

7th Aldermanic District
N. 52nd St. - W. Nash St. to W. Capitol Dr. (ST211141123): Install traffic calming speed hump(s). (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$19,100; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$1,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$21,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2015-2016 construction season.

N. 53rd St. - W. Vienna Ave. to W. Capitol Dr. (TD0428401B): Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace curb and gutter and sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (7-foot width of tree border area), and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$14,000 (ST211150200); TID 42 Funds - \$250,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$275,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2015-2016 construction season.

8th Aldermanic District
W. Branting Ln. - S. 37th St. to S. 38th St. (ST211150207): Install traffic calming speed hump(s). (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$3,100; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$1,400). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$4,500. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2015-2016 construction season.

4th Aldermanic District
S. 71st St. - W. Klinckinnic River Pkwy. to W. Cleveland Ave. (ST211140107) File Number 120112: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (9-foot width of tree border area), and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$32,500; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund - \$200,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$255,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2016 construction season.

Whereas, The report of the Commissioner of Public Works has been filed with the City Clerk; and Whereas, Notices have been sent to all interested persons and public hearings held; now, therefore, be it Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Commissioner of Public Works Report, as amended at said Public Hearing, is approved and the properties therein identified are benefited; and, be it

Further Resolved, That said Commissioner of Public Works is authorized and directed to proceed with said work in accordance with said report pursuant to Section 66.0703 and any other pertinent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes and in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting or adjacent properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer
