To Whom It May Concern:

I, Obbie Ward Sr. am requesting to file a claim against the City of Milwaukee Police Department for the following reasons. On Thursday, September 16, 2004, the police burst into my home located at 4032 N. 17th Street to arrest my son Obbie Ward Jr. (who has Cerebral Palsy and is confined to a wheelchair). Upon entering my house, they knocked my front door completely down, broke the glass and ruined the door frame. The police then destroyed my home turning thing over and leaving the house a complete mess. They also removed two computer hard drives (which belonged to my son) and two guns that belonged to my. I informed the officers that the guns were mine they still removed them from the house. The officer's lack of respect and improper behavior has caused my family great distress. My wife and I are senior citizens who were left to clean up a mess that could've easily been avoided if they would've rang the door bell or knocked on the door. They also removed my son from the house without his wheelchair which goes against he rights as a handicap citizen. The actions of the officers placed my family in a great deal of danger. They had no concern as to who could have been sitting by the door. My wife could have been seriously injured if she wouldn't have moved out of the way. My granddaughter could've brnn hurt or even killed if she were visiting that day. They also left my family in danger because the door they destroyed could not provide the protection that we needed from the outside. Therefore I would like to enter a claim to sue the Milwaukee Police Department for the amount of \$30,000. I would like \$3000 for the door and door frame, please see attached estimate. I would like \$3000 for the two guns that were removed from the house, and \$24,000 for the stress and heartache they caused my family.

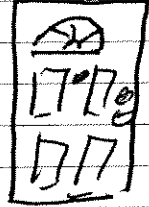

TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONFORMING TO WISCONSIN CONSTRUCTION LIEN LAW

"As required by the Wisconsin Construction Lien Law, Builder hereby notifies Owner that persons or companies furnishing labor or materials for the construction on Owner's land may have lien rights on Owner's land and building if not paid. Those entitled to lien rights, in addition to the undersigned Builder, are those who contract directly with the Owner or those who give the Owner notice within 60 days after they first furnish labor or materials for the construction.

Accordingly, owner probably will receive notices from those who furnish labor or materials for the construction, and should give a copy of each notice received to his mortgage lender, if any. Builder agrees to cooperate with the Owner and his lender, if any, to see that all potential lien claimants are duly paid.

This is a home improvement instrument and is non-negotiable. Every holder takes subject to all claims and defenses of the maker or obligor.
