WHEREAS, *On January 14, 2015, Rescue 2 arrived on the scene of a fire at 7730 W. Villard Ave.; and*

WHEREAS, *Rescue 2 demonstrated teamwork and bravery when responding to the burning duplex, and performed the rescue of a boy after finding him unconscious and not breathing; and*

WHEREAS, *Rescue 2 has served the Milwaukee Fire Department with honor and dedication and has always executed their duties with the greatest of skill and pride; and*

WHEREAS, *While fire lieutenant Timothy J. Leszczynski, heavy equipment operator Aaron M. Kreil, firefighter Jason M. Ross, firefighter David E. Jauch and firefighter Lorenzo A. Williams are recognized for their bravery on the job, their actions and concern for the well-being of co-workers and of the citizens they work to protect are representative of all of the men and women of the Milwaukee Fire Department, who engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education, and who are committed to providing whatever assistance the citizens of Milwaukee need; now, therefore, be it*
