Re: **The Moderne:** EBE and RPP Data through December 31, 2011

Dear Ms. Purvis:

This report addresses the participation of EBE firms and RPP workers on The Moderne, where construction is ahead of schedule to complete the tallest structure in downtown Milwaukee west of the Milwaukee River. Developer Barrett Visionary Development, Contractor J.H. Findorff & Son and Coordinator Prism Technical are fully committed to meeting at least 25% EBE participation on the \$29.5 million adjusted construction budget and utilizing at least 30% RPP workers on the project, which will have 203 apartments and 14 condominiums when complete.

EBE Participation

EBE Participation remains robust, with EBE firms earning nearly \$3 million through December 31, 2011 (see detail in the table below), or 29.8% of the adjusted construction spending of \$9,986,364, as reported by Findorff.

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RPP Participation

Through December 31, 2011, there were 94,309.8 onsite construction hours. Of those hours, 29,427 were worked by individuals certified under the City of Milwaukee Residents Preference Program, yielding an **RPP percentage of 31.2%**. Continued vigilance by Findorff and Prism should ensure that the project remain on track to yield an RPP percentage of at least 30% by completion.
