Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. 5. On 03/28/23 at 1:42p.m., officers were dispatched to the area of N. 49th St., and W. Villard Ave., for a Shots Fired call. Officers observed a group of people assisting what appeared to be an intoxicated patron from the bar located at 4923 W. Villard Av. At no time during the investigation did any one flag officers down or appear in distress. A short time later, a victim of a shooting arrived at a hospital in the same vehicle officers observed earlier. Officers interviewed a gas station clerk from across the street as well as a resident from above the bar, both stated they heard the gun shots. Officers returned to the bar to investigate, however, it was closed.

On Tuesday March 28, 2023, at approximately 1:42am PO Andrew KELLER and I responded to the area of N. 49th St and W. Villard Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, for a shots fired complaint. The caller stated she heard gunshots from this area, possibly from the Gas Station (Citgo 4929 W. Villard Ave) or the "Bar", (Jack's Executive Bistro, 4923 W. Villard Ave.) The caller indicated they heard multiple shots fired at different times a few minutes apart.

We arrived on scene and checked the area of N. 49th St. and W. Villard Ave and also the parking lot of the bar area, where patrons were seen coming and going from the bar. There were no signs of distress from any of the patrons at this time. We checked with the clerk at the gas station who stated that he heard the shots, but they may have come from just east of the location in the roadway. During our initial investigation there were no signs of any objects struck or injuries including having driven through the bar parking lot and parking in the lot west of the bar while patrons exited the bar.

We did observe, while in the Citgo parking lot across the street from the bar, a group of people assist what appeared to be an intoxicated individual from the bar into a red Dodge Charger. We did flash our spotlight on them as while they were doing this there was a very loud conversation going on amongst the driver and passengers that included statements along the lines of "just get them into the car". The vehicle then left the parking lot after noticing officers. At no time did any of the passengers attempt to flag down officers for any assistance.

A short time later a shooting victim arrived at St. Mary's hospital in a red Dodge Charger stating they had been shot at Jack's Executive Bistro. The B/F stated that she was outside on the sidewalk in front of the bar when a vehicle driving by shot in her direction and she realized she was struck.

At no time did dispatch receive any calls from this location regarding a shooting victim nor did any patrons attempt to flag down officers that were in the immediate area. When officers returned to the location after the victim arrived at the hospital the business was closed and no representative from the establishment was present. There are cameras on the street side of the building that could assist in this investigation but were not able to be viewed.

We also spoke with the resident that lives above the bar during our investigation and the B/M stated he did hear gunshots but that it wasn't unusual to hear them and did not think much of it. He stated he did not hear anything other than a few shots and a vehicle leave the area.

Sgt. Paul GRACZYK responded to this scene.

You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


