Initial Youth Council Selection Process Prepared by Youth Council Selection Committee Last Revised: 10/29/04

- 1. Pursuant to the requirements of s. 320-45-6-b, the Youth Council Selection Committee will submit this document with attachments to the Common Council for its review and approval at the Common Council's November 3, 2004 meeting. This packet consists of the following parts:
 - a. A letter of introduction and instruction to the applicant from the Selection Committee. (Exhibit A)
 - b. A four-page application to be completed by the prospective member of the Youth Council. Please note that the first page of this form includes a waiver that must be signed by the applicant's parent or guardian. Among other things, it requires the parent or guardian to certify that the applicant is a U.S. citizen or legal resident. (Exhibit B)
 - c. A recommendation form to be completed by an adult unrelated to the prospective member of the Youth Council. (Exhibit C)
 - d. Two nomination petition forms. Each applicant will be required to solicit signatures from 50 of their peers (young people aged 18 or under) who are also residents of the City of Milwaukee. (Exhibit D)
- 2. It is anticipated that this document with attachments will be reviewed by the Community and Economic Development Committee at its meeting on November 16, 2004.
- 3. It is anticipated that this document with attachments will be approved by the Common Council at its meeting on November 23, 2004.
- 4. Following the approval of the Common Council, application materials will be distributed as widely as possible throughout the community. In addition, efforts will be made to publicize this opportunity. This effort will include:
 - a. Posting all application materials on the City of Milwaukee's website.
 - b. The use of press releases from member(s) of the Common Council.
 - c. Advertising the Youth Council application process on the City of Milwaukee's "City Channel 25".
 - d. Contracting with the "Urban Underground" to conduct a public awareness campaign for the Youth Council. The Youth Council Selection Committee will meet with representatives of that organization on November 3, 2004, to work out the details of this arrangement.

- 5. All application materials including recommendation forms must be delivered to the office of the Common Council City Clerk by 4:45 p.m. on Monday, January 10, 2005. When application forms are received, the following process will be observed:
 - a. Applications will be checked for completeness. Applicants who have submitted complete forms will be notified of this by either e-mail (preferably) or by mail. Applicants who have submitted incomplete forms will be notified of any deficiencies by either e-mail (preferably) or by mail. In either case, all materials must still be submitted by the January 10, 2005, deadline. This paragraph is intended, in part, to satisfy the "correction of deficiencies" requirement of s.320-45-6-b of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
 - b. Applications will have their cover pages removed (as containing identifying information) and will be numbered in the following manner: "(Aldermanic District) (Ordinal rank of application within that district based on when it was received.)"
 - c. As applications are received and processed, they will be sent out, probably once or twice a week, to Selection Committee members. Shortly after January 10, 2005, packets containing all remaining applications received will be provided to each of the five members of the Selection Committee.
- 6. Each member of the Selection Committee will review all applications and evaluate them using the attached form (Exhibit E) with the exception that, should the two youth members of the Selection Committee apply for membership on the Youth Council, they will not review any of the applications from their aldermanic district. Based on this evaluation, each applicant will receive a score of between 0 and 200 points. This evaluation process should be completed by the end of January 2005.
- 7. The three applicants receiving the highest scores in each of the City's aldermanic districts will be contacted for interviews before the Selection Committee. In those cases where more than three applicants share the highest score in their district, the Selection Committee will decide, by consensus or, if necessary, by vote, which of the applicants to invite for interviews based on a review of their recommendation forms. (Exhibit C)
- 8. By consensus or, if necessary, vote, the Selection Committee will select the candidate from each of the 15 aldermanic districts to recommend to the Common Council for membership on the Milwaukee Youth Council. These recommendations should be submitted to the Common Council in time for its March 16, 2005 meeting.

To All the Applicants for the Milwaukee Youth Council:

First, on behalf of all of the members of the Youth Council Selection Committee, I want to thank you for your interest in the Youth Council and your desire to serve all the citizens of the City of Milwaukee. Please be advised that there are some requirements for participation as a member of the Youth Council. These are:

- 1. You must be 18 years of age or younger at the time your nomination is approved by the Common Council. This is expected to be in March or April 2005.
- 2. You must be a citizen or legal resident of the United States
- 3. You must be a resident of the City of Milwaukee.
- 4. You must have achieved high school status. You do not have to be attending a traditional high school, but, if you're not, you'll have to tell us a bit more about your educational situation and be able to show us that you are pursuing your education.

Be aware that if you fail to meet any of these qualifications, we cannot consider your application. Attached to this letter you will find an application form. It consists of the following parts:

- ☐ Section I: About Yourself (1 page)
- ☐ Section II: Describe Yourself (2 pages)
- ☐ Section III: Express Yourself (1 page)
- ☐ Section IV: Recommendation (1 page)
- ☐ Section V: Nomination Papers (2 identical pages)

Make sure you have all five sections listed. The first three sections are for you to fill out. Section IV is to be filled out and returned to the City by an unrelated adult who you think knows you well. Section V requires you to go out among your peers and gather 50 signatures (two sheets, 25 signatures on each) from people 18 years of age and under who are residents of the City of Milwaukee and who support your candidacy for the Youth Council. When you have completed Sections I-III and V, you have two options for delivering them:

2. You can hand-deliver them to the above-address any time between 8 a.m. and 4:45 p.m., Monday through Friday.

All materials must be received no later than 4: 45 p.m. on January 10, 2005. This applies to your recommendation form as well as the rest of the application.

The Selection Committee hopes to finish its review of completed applications by the end of January 2005 and begin interviewing finalists during the first week of February. The ordinance creating the Youth Council permits us to choose only one Youth Council member from each of the City's 15 aldermanic districts. We will be notifying all candidates of our decisions during the month of March 2005.




