AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPC RTATION AND THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT

I-94 N-S Freeway Project

This agreement is a formal partnership, made and entered into between the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DEPARTMENT) and the City of Mi waukee Police Department (CITY), to provide for services as described herein. The Visconsin Department of Transportation and City of Milwaukee Police Department are partiering during the I-94 N-S Freeway Project (PROJECT) to ensure that emergency response capabilities are not adversely affected by roadway reconstruction.

The DEPARTMENT advises implementation of a comprehe sive and cost effective transportation management plan that will help ensure the safety, ac ressibility and mobility for the traveling public in the PROJECT area. The PROJECT area is def ned as interstates I-94, I-43 and I-894 from College Avenue on the south, Loomis Road on the vest and Howard Avenue on the north. Included in the PROJECT area are local alternate route streets within two miles of the interstate roadways.

To mitigate traffic impacts caused by the PROJECT, the DEPARTI IENT will provide \$75,000 to the CITY. In turn, the CITY will provide planning, coordination and staffing services (as outlined below) in an effort to mitigate emergency incidents in the PROJECT area and stay informed of PROJECT roadway closures and construction progress for a 2-year period commencing on January 1, 2011 and ending on December 31, 2012.

The monies provided by this agreement will allow for CITY to assist in:

- Traffic control assistance during changing traffic patterns and freeway closures
- Attendance at weekly construction traffic meetings
- Speed enforcement on alternate routes and other local roads
- Evaluation of emergency access and traffic control plans
- Assist in development of a Incident Crisis Communications F an
- Participation in incident "dry run" exercises

Enforcement Enhancements

The CITY shall provide additional enforcement to keep alternate rot les open and traffic moving. These enhancement services will allow for quicker first responses to crashes on key alternate routes, quicker incident removals, and added presence at sensitive fa cilities (schools, parks, etc.). The CITY shall also assist in securing incident/crisis scenes on city streets and attend PROJECT related construction progress meetings and coordinating closure sche lules when necessary.

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Basis of Payment

The CITY shall charge actual costs incurred and attributable to the work performed and described above under this agreement to the DEPARTMENT. The DI PARTMENT will provide to the CITY reimbursable funding for these functions in the amount of \$75,000. Total reimbursement to the CITY for traffic mitigation measures under this agreement will not exceed \$75,000. Billings shall be directed by the City to the attention of Chris Hager, Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Southeast Region, 141 NW Barst w Street, P.O. Box 798, Waukesha, WI 53187-0798 and will include a statement of expenses supported by a description of items and services provided and expended. The DEPARTME NT shall pay the billings promptly upon receipt thereof.
