Regarding: Your Class B Tavern and Food Dealer License Applications as agent for "Milwaukee Athletic Club" for "Milwaukee Athletic Club" at 731 N WATER St #190.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

5. On 04/26/2016 David HINTON provided the Police with a signed affidavit regarding the business located at 731 N. Water St. The affidavit states the business will operate as a live music lounge featuring Jazz and will not have a dance floor. The business will not have third party promoters and will not have a DJ or play pre-recorded music. The business will have security after 7:00pm and close the Riverwalk doors at 9pm weekdays and 11pm on weekends.
 6. On 06/25/2016 an officer received complaints regarding noise from Good Life at 735 N. Water St. One complaint was for the night of 06/26/2016 at 12:30am. The complainant stated there was loud music shaking his walls from Good Life. He had walked over and observed a DJ playing music. Another complaint was for a Sunday at 12:57am. The complaint was again for a DJ playing extremely loud music and the doors being left open for the Riverwalk. On 07/01/2016 the officer spoke with HINTON who stated he didn't have a DJ he had a guy named "Don" playing music downloaded onto a computer. HINTON was issued a citation for Excessive noise prohibited.

7. On 10/07/2016 Officers were dispatched to the Good Life Bar, at 731 N Water Street, for a trouble with subject. Upon arrival officers observed patrons leaving the club and causing a disturbance. The patrons were being loud and walking in the street, which caused traffic to slow down. After patrons got into their vehicles there was a large cruising problem in the immediate area.
8. On 12/23/2016 at 2:50am officers investigated a property damage complaint at the parking structure at 100 E. Wisconsin Ave. An unknown subject damaged the toll booth arm allowing cars to exit without paying. The security officer stated at this hour the only business open is the Good Life Bar and he suspects the damage was done by patrons of the bar.
9. On 03/16/2017 there was a meeting held at District One regarding The Good Life, 731 N. Water St. in relation to ongoing violations of their PEP and plan of operation. The applicant and Co-Owner David HINTON were in attendance as well as Captain Diana ROWE. The applicant was advised of the concerns of the police which included use of a DJ, a promoter, loud music and general disorder on Thursday nights. HINTON refuted the use of DJ's and promoters. After discussing the concerns HINTON stated he would make changes and did not think he broke any rules.

10. On 03/24/2017 officers conducted a tavern check at The Good Life Bar, 731 N. Water St. The officers stated the music was being played at a level which required the officers to raise their voices and lean in to each other to be heard. This was in violation of the affidavit filed by the applicant which stated the music would be played at a conversational level.
11. On 03/29/2017 an officer meet with Maleta BROWN a representative of The Hertz Investment Group and Jason SUDNIK a representative of Impark, which operates the parking structures at 100 E. Wisconsin Av and 720 N. Water St. BROWN stated that since The Good Life has opened the gates at the parking structure have been damaged 6 times. She stated the damage has been done around closing time on Thursday and Saturday nights, which are nights The Good Life runs promotional events. The damage cost \$1,919 to repair and has allowed approximately 70 cars to exit without paying. BROWN provided 12 incidents reports from security officers documenting the incidents that occurred between 11/13/2016 and 03/26/2017. The incidents were related to parking disputes and drivers manually lifting the gate to exit without paying. The incident on 11/13/2016 involved two cars and a review of the tape revealed one of the occupants had pointed a gun at the security guard. On 03/31/2017 the officer monitored closing time at The Good Life. He found it to be disorderly with security struggling to disperse the crowd. There were no thefts at the parking structure because they instituted a pre-pay policy. The exiting cars did congest the roadway in front of The Good Life and were playing loud music.
12. **David HINTON (50% shareholder) has a warrant with Milwaukee County Sheriff for Failure to Support (warrant#2016008657, date 07/30/2016)**



13. On 05/05/17 at 1:30am, Milwaukee Police observed security from the tavern located at 731 N. Water Street (Good Life) escorting two subjects outside the establishment. A verbal altercation ensued with other patrons who exited the tavern and police, along with security, had to separate the groups. Police entered the establishment to take with the owner and found that they were in violation of an affidavit which stated, "The business will not feature DJ's and will not play recorded music, other than background or ambiance music played at conversational levels.
14. On 07/28/17 at, 1:30 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 731 N. Water Street (Good Life) for a shots fired complaint. Investigation revealed, for an eyewitness and a surveillance camera, that a subject exited a vehicle in the street and began to argue with security staff at the "Good Life" tavern. The subject fired one shot, and then fled in his vehicle. When officer's interviewed the security guard involved, he denied any involvement and said that there were no shots fired. The owner of the establishment was also uncooperative with police.
15. On 09/05/17 at 3:00pm, a meeting was held at the First District Police Station regarding Item #14. The owner, who failed to show up for the first scheduled meeting, told the Police Captain that he could not be responsible for false statement and/or misrepresentations of events to police by his employees. The owner was told that his employees will be interviewed during official investigations.

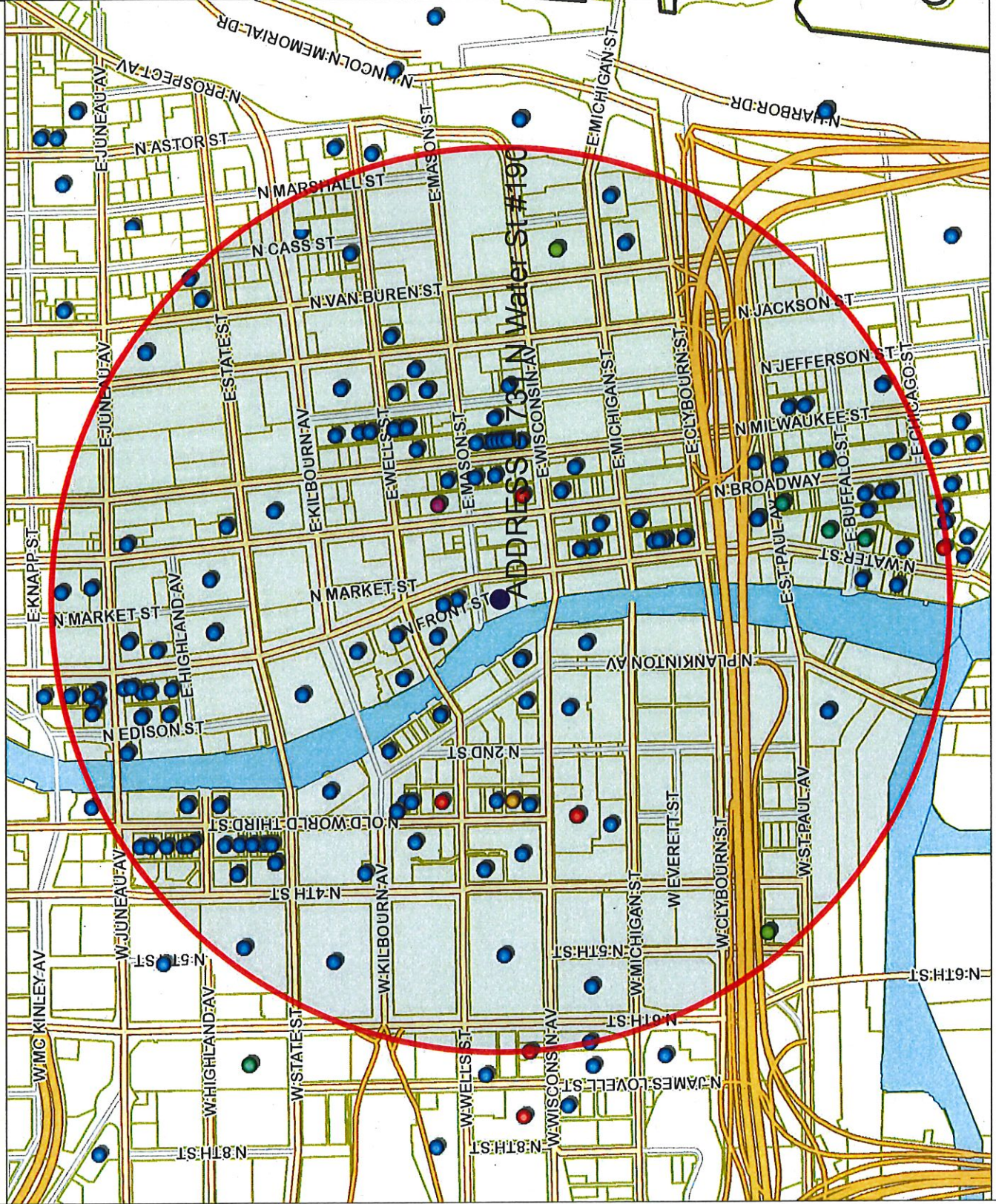
