In the 2004 Proposed Budget, 643 positions were eliminated. Of these positions, 102 employees were identified as being potentially displaced due to departmental budget requests. As of today, 60 of the incumbents in these positions have been placed in other city positions. The Department of Employee Relations will continue to make every effort to place the remaining 42 employees who may face layoff at the end of the year in other vacant city positions.
