File # 041501 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Kids First/Safe Routes to School Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Kids First/Safe Routes to School Grant from the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance, through the Milwaukee Public Schools.
- 2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this project is to deploy police officers on overtime to enforce traffic, pedestrian and criminal laws in the neighborhoods enabling children to walk to school in a safe environment.
- 2. Officers will be assigned to targeted neighborhood school areas in order to provide a higher level of enforcement.

Fiscal Effect

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$41,299 with \$25,000 from the grantor and a city share of \$16,299.
- 2. This grant will fund overtime costs for officers engaged in this project. The city share includes personnel costs, fringe benefits and indirect expenses (\$4,238) related to the grant administration.
