Dear Council Members:

The City of Milwaukee has been advised by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) that 90 percent federal funding is available for traffic control improvements at four intersections under the 2003 Small Hazard Elimination Safety (HES) Program.

We have requested and received preliminary approval from the WISDOT along with the attached project agreement to be executed by the City of Milwaukee for programming and construction of the traffic control improvements at the locations listed in the attached resolution. The total estimated construction cost is \$22,608 of which \$2,512 is the City's share.

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We have, therefore, prepared and recommend adoption of the attached resolution authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Public Works to execute the agreement. The resolution also authorizes and directs the City Comptroller to transfer funds to the project sub-account for the estimated costs of preliminary engineering and plan preparation for this project. The estimated preliminary engineering amount for this project is \$2,500, which is the City's responsibility.
