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CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: State your name and
address for the record.

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ALLYN WASLEY: Allyn Wasley, 1408 American
Avenue, Waukesha.

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TRACY WASLEY: Tracy Wasley, 1408 American
Avenue.

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CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: And Mr. Wasley, do you
admit to receiving notice in the mail there's a
possibility your application could be denied because
of items contained on the police report?

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ALLYN WASLEY: Yes, I do.

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CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Health Department?

HEALTH DEPARTMENT: Health Department does
need an inspection of the premises.

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CHAIRMAN WITKOWIAK: Neighborhood Services.
