The purpose of this project award is to increase adult immunization rates within the City of Milwaukee. Specifically this project will aim to increase adult immunization rates for seasonal influenza and HPV vaccination through community engagement, providing resources and materials to area providers, and sending reminder postcards to adult clients of the City of Milwaukee Health Department's Immunization Clinics.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This program relates to the City-wide goal to enhance the health and well-being of Milwaukee residents by improving access to preventive health care; promote healthy behaviors; reduce racial and ethnic health disparities; and improve the quality of healthcare information and coordination of services.

Activities under this grant contribute to the MHD goal of increasing immunization rates within the City of Milwaukee, and build upon other interventions done by the department.
