Blue: buckthorn, invasive species on DNR's official restricted list

Orange: juniper bushes. Southern one is severely damaged and spreading disease to adjacent crapabble tree. North juniper is undesired Yellow: pines for removal. Corner Austrian pine is unhealthy. Center Scotch Pine is near death and obstructs nearly all light from living room.
