This file authorizes the Department of City Development (DCD) to accept a \$44,148 Regranting Program Grant from the State of Wisconsin Arts Boards. The City's share is \$22,074, which will be a cash contribution. The funds will be used to award grants to Milwaukee art organizations or neighborhood-based organizations that conduct art-related programming.

## **Background**

- 1. The City of Milwaukee provides small grants to neighborhood organizations for art related activities each year for a variety of projects.
- 2. This grant supplements the \$217,000 provided in the 2001 Budget for the Milwaukee Arts Board Projects Special Purpose Account (SPA). In 2000, \$192,000 was provided in this SPA.
- 3. Each year, if the state has unspent funds, those funds are divided between Milwaukee and Madison. The availability of those funds varies from year to year.
- 4. In 2000, 27 projects received funding from the Milwaukee Arts Board.

## Discussion

- 1. This grant will continue to provide funding for art groups. The Milwaukee Arts Board is in the process of making funding recommendations for groups seeking funding for 2001-2002.
- 2. The grant will operate from June 30, 2001 to June 30, 2002.
- 3. The City's cash donation of \$22,074 will come from the Milwaukee Arts Board Projects SPA.

## **Fiscal Impact**

The resolution authorizes the expenditure of \$44,148 from the grant aid account for the Wisconsin Arts Board Regranting Program.
